Bulls-7

A show that can only be described as mixed, with just about every size and shape represented. Top PPK to 191PPK from JMT Engineering for Limousin x, with a top gross figure from Robert and Bert Mitchell selling Charolais x to ± 1201

Steers-19

What a show! Some super goods on offer really topping the pops today. Top PPK today shared between Pete Jarrom and Frank Page, selling to 238PPK for a British Blue x and a Limousin x. Plenty of weight throughout the entry seeing 745KG Steers from PC & RA Nichols to 191PPK. Top gross today from Frank to £1449, with Blues from The Nichols stable to £1422.

Heifers-29

Butchers and Wholesalers both fit for best heifers today and trade really rocking to a top of 246PPK for a Limousin x Heifer from Frank Page, with others from the same home to 229PPK. No end of handy Heifers up over 210PPK. Top gross today from Frank Page selling to £1564, for possibly the best Heifer I have seen in this ring for some time.

Cows-12

Simply ballistic. Cows as dear as I have ever seen them. Top PPK in the section again from Frank Page, with British Blue x cows to 172PPK, or grossing a whopping £1347. Three of todays entry trading over the £1300 figure. More cows and overage cattle are desperately wanted.

SPRING LAMBS: 2339 FORWARD SQQ 228.8P/KG

A good even yarding numbers wise today with just over 2300. Quality starting to drop off in the heat and plenty of half meat in the alleys today. Best end lambs a flying trade and perhaps a result of a widening gap between the best end quality and the general quality being sold nationally. Fed meat lambs now paying better than any year before and a definite premium on display. All foreign accounts firing well today albeit egged on by each other despite prior caution before the sale. An SQQ of 228.8p/kg a massive return and seemingly an increased trade on the early morning trade for the day with Continental order building during the morning. Best Export lambs topping today at 272p/kg from M J Woodward, Leicester at 41.5kg for Beltex ahead of H Collins & Son's Beltex at 39.5kg to 271p/kg. N Walker, Burford saw her pen in the last few of the day sold to 269p/kg at 39kg ahead of happy chappy Norman Deeley at 267p/kg for 44kg. In the heavies an ever increasing demand it seems insofar as meat is concerned. 46kg from F H Everett & Son, Shipston on Stour saw 246p/ kg for Texels with Norm Deeley 48kg to 246p/kg and 47kg 243p/kg with lovely shape and finish from Jean Herod 52kg to 240p/kg. In the lump Export lambs continuing to add up with the entire yarding averaging £97. Norman Deeley the man of the moment selling to a top for the SOO weight class of £117.50 at 44kg whilst Woody saw 41.5kg to £113 and 42kg at £112. Jean Herod and D M Herrick equal at 43kg to £110. Weight though does pay and heavies enjoying an encouraging following despite the continued scaled back approach to general Catering Nationally. Top of the Pops today to P & LA Gibbs, Harbury with £126 at 67kg with Jean Herod £125 for 52kg and E J Taylor & Son, Banbury £120. Some nice runs today to counteract those lacking meat with vendors such as JCB Farms selling 104 Texels to avg 42.8kg at £100.40. Meat wanted and we all continue to hold our breath as to how long this wonderful season for lamb Sales will remain so buoyant.
