Real premiums for top end lambs with shape Blue Texel plumbs from A J Geary at 38kg to 479p/kg with E Brain & Son 40.5kg at 469p/kg and Willy Warner real shape Beltex to 467p/kg equal with Ted Taylor both first draws. Shape trading regularly 440p/kg for anything with shape and finish. Weight an easier trade today with the swap from Hoggs nearly complete. Top in the weight 49kg to 419p/kg for D M Leedham with Tommy Tustian 46.5kg at 419p/kg whom also sold 48kg at 417p/kg equal with Fordwell Farms. In the lump Export weights topped at £200 for F Johnson-Gibbs at 45kg with Hyde Lane Farms 45.5kg to £197 and J & R Lowe 44kg £194 and £193.




