Trade as dear as we have ever seen with buyers holding an appetite that we simply couldn't fill. Headlines all around the shed but perhaps the main highlight the sheer trade for the O+ meat. Simply astounding.

Steers;

Meat on parade and rewarded massively throughout. R Grades all in the 240p/kg plus with Angus to 246p/kg from DJ Hull & Partners. Finish key and R grades upto 253p/kg from RJ Heckford. U Grades rewarded well seeing Jack Gibson show his first Limousin Steers to 259.5p/kg and 255p/kg. Weight no issue and just a fraction under 700kg from RW & HER Trivett taking 260.5p/kg. Top man today though a Blonde Steer full of meat and finish from DR & JC Bennett with 672kg taking 280p/kg. Gross the real story of the day seeing a Messrs Trivett take £1712 and £1819 before top man for the day Messrs Bennett £1882!!

Heifers;

Exactly the same story as the Steers meat on display and everything wanted and chased throughout. Not the wealth of grade in the Heifers with Most O+ and selling to 243p/kg whilst R Grades 246p/kg and U+ for a super blocky Heifer with finish and depth from GR Fountaine & Son selling to a massive 287p/kg. £1700 the top trade today for the Fountaines with Messrs Trivett £1590 and Ed Hull Salers to £1495. Some trade and to see is to believe.

Bulls;

Just a single solitary Bull from Messrs Lowe with a super little fed Bull took 602kg at 240.5p/kg returning £1448.Many more wanted.

OTM/Cows;

Weight paying seeing overage South Devon Steers from Messrs Lee return £1821 and others £1628. Cows;

Hard to find today and only just over 1400 forward as producers struggle for meat throughout the area. Trade simply amazing and an SQQ of 247p/kg a blistering trade for the goods on show with all accounts firing on every pen. Best end lambs well chased throughout and a definite move for extra demand in lightweight and export lambs. Top today a small but perfectly formed Beltex from team Wadland at 329p/kg with Messrs Fountain showing the same to 297p/kg and PD & DM Hopcraft 37kg to 292p/kg. SM Ellingworth, Market Harbrough and R Richins, Oxford both 277p/kg with a lovely pen of meat from Jo Webster, Southam 42kg to 276p/kg with Culworth Grounds 40kg also 276p/kg. Today plenty of Lambs north of 260p/kg and those feeding the lambs being rewarded times over. Heavy meat chased all day and a top of 280p/kg at 49kg from DS & LE Wadland, Aston Le Walls. Bob Richins, Oxford showed the goods at 46kg at 274p/kg with 46.5kg to 273p/kg. F Moon 51.5kg to 272p/kg. Export lambs chased harder than we have seen and topping at £123.50 for 45kg from R Richin who sold 43.5kg to £120.50 with new vendor G Wilson 44kg to £120 and 43kg from Messrs Wadland £118. Heavies the flavour of the day selling to a massive £151 at 56kg from R F Wilson with another new vendor J A Owen, Bicester selling 62kg to £150 and D E Collett 66kg to £149.50.
