Spring Lambs: 2859 Forward SQQ 246.87p/kg

Just shy of the 3000 mark today with numbers coming forward at speed. Numbers and the loss of three buyers this week though, seemingly not affecting the trade that levelled at 246p/kg SQQ. Two buyers unable to get going at the level of trade and one not even venturing north after last weeks flying trade. Trade today from start to finish and all genuine farmers sheep sold at as an arms-length transaction. Spec lambs the most wanted commodity with a dearth of light weights perhaps pulling the averages back a little. Today 882 Lambs trading over 250p/kg. In the Euro Spec section a top today of 275p/kg from Andrew Amor with very good yet superlight 28kg Texels. James Grindal just off the top this week at 273p/kg for 37kg and G Gregory 272p/kg for 37kg. In the heavies a top p/kg of 245p/kg for 47.5kg from MM Clarke & Sons, whilst Pritchard Farms 45.5kg to 240p/kg equal price with Boulton Bros for 50kg. In the gross top Euro lambs today to £113 for 44kg from Richard Lowe whilst Baylis Partners saw 45.5kg to £112.50 and MM Clarke & Sons 44kg to £112. Overall a top of £120 for Boulton Bros at 50kg with M M Clarke & Sons £ 116.50 twice at 47.50 kg & 48kg. Trade a real flyer with many having tickets back that average in the 260p/kg regions. Miles ahead of deadweight comparison, with the markets nationally serving a purpose to furnish buyers with quality Spring Lambs and in return show the real level of demand at this current time.

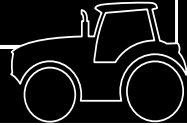
