#### Bulls-4

Only a handful forward today and many more could have been sold to advantage. Top PPK today to Alan Tacy, selling Angus x Bulls to 174PPK and topping the gross at £1216. More Bulls are required each week.

#### Steers-19

The Steers today would include everything from the best end, to over age Welsh Blacks, to plain Friesians. Top PPK today from G Hutsby & Sons showing properly fed, home bred Limousin x Steers to 235PPK. Top gross today from Frank Hodgkin with Limousin x up to £1478. Better end U-/R grading Bullocks all well up over 210PPK.

#### Heifers-30

The majority of the entry today and an absolute pleasure to sell. Best sorts flying up to 235PPK for Limousin x from Parry Walters, with two more from the same stable to 232PPK. Top gross again from Parry to £1412. U- sorts all 215PPK and above with handy weighted cattle really ringing the bell.

Two short of 2000 lambs a manufactured decrease in numbers to suit the drop in demand caused by the Annual Bastille day celebrations on the Continent. A prolonged holiday as a result of the Festival acts to decrease numbers demanded annually as was witnessed Monday Morning with Deadweights suspending bookings. 2000 an easily handled number for the buyers on show and the result another cracking trade returning 227p/kg SQQ. Best end lambs wanted throughout as the top end dry up and quality takes a definite fall. Long distance men top today from S & D Collie selling Beltex to 298p/kg at 40kg ahead of a pen full of quality from MM Clarke & Sons 40kg to 271p/kg whilst Beltex breeder SF Taylor, Coventry took 266p/kg and 267p/kg at 40 and 37.5kg. P Cobley saw 38kg to 262p/kg. Heavies really wanted today and meat and shape rewarded throughout. Heavies to 258p/kg at 46.5kg from MM Clarke & Sons with local dairymen JT Jeyes 242p/kg at 48kg and Humphrey Livestock 46kg to 239p/kg. Trade for Meat, Shape and Ram lambs all on another level from standard quality lambs today. Really adding up today to see £119 for 40kg from Messrs Collie whilst 45kg from MM Clarke & Sons saw £113 and Humphrey Livestock £110 at 42.5kg.
