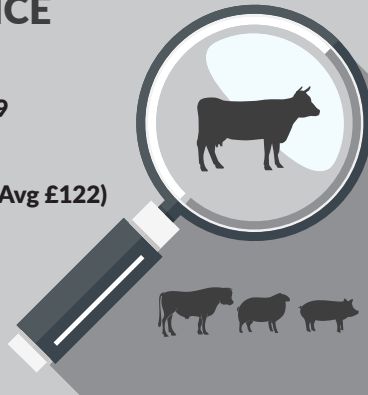

Weight paying for Messrs Allen returning £1805 sold to Messrs MutchMeats, Oxford. The Allen family also returning £1708, £1638 and £1578 ahead of Ed Hull at £1565 a good advertisement for his 60 Store Cattle on Thursday.. O Grades today trading well past 210p/kg.

Heifers; Meat wanted and Meat on show. The Arable Boys of Warwickshire showing the Cattle men how it is done with properly fed Heifers from G Hutsby & Sons returning 259.5p/kg with PC & RA Nichols 242p/kg. Meated lambs all trading well over 300p/kg but some lacking backs today 10p/kg behind breeding for breeding. Heavies best to sell and a top of 335p/kg at 49kg from Fordwell Farms Ltd, Cambes with 50kg from MM Clarke & Sons at 320p/kg and others 316p/kg at 46.5kg.
