Top gross to £1576 from F Hodgkin and £1516 from team Fountaine.

#### Heifers;

Top of the Pops for the Fountaine team with shape finish and weight to see 256p/kg for a U+ at 648kg returning £1659! ### SHEEP: 1709 FORWARD AVG £127 PRIME HOGGS: 1322 FORWARD SQQ 300P/KG

SQQ on fire and a Market avg over £127 all from genuine farmers sheep!! Well to see is to believe. Numbers hard to come by today with under 1400 penned but that said a trade that for a fraction of a decimal place returned an SQQ of 300p/kg!!!!! Buyers all around and quality dealt with as appropriate. Not only top of the Cattle but also the Hoggs the 'King of Milton Keynes' Richard Fountaine saw 37.5kg Beltex take 379p/kg ahead of the Prince of Brackley, Humphrey Livestock 366p/kg to 40kg whilst Bailey & Moore, Leicester saw 39kg to 363p/kg M & C Morris saw Beltex at 36kg to 358p/kg with J B Elkington 42kg to 352p/kg. Today over a third of all Hoggs forward 300p/kg or more. Heavies not discounted at all with trade sharp throughout topping at 345p/kg for 47kg from L Smart, Northleach bringing quality for the first time to these Shores and returning 47kg to 345p/kg with 48.5kg to 334p/kg. Jack Lombard 48kg to 323p/ kg and Humphrey Livestock 46kg to 320p/kg J E Thorpe, North Yorks 47kg to 307p/kg this run of 127 avg 3.01pkg at 42.56kg. In the Lump a top today for Euro weight Hoggs of £158 for M & C Morris, Braunston at 45kg with J B Elkington 43kg to £150 and others 42kg to £148. Overall though today L Smart, Cirencester reigns supreme seeing a top of £162 for 47kg and 48.5kg with 53kg also £162. P Edwards, Stratford Upon Avon 66kg to £158 and S & D North 51kg to £156.

Trade absolutely on fire throughout and Sustainability may be an issue going forward with one Wholesaler suggesting that he could now afford to sell Fillets of Beef cheaper than Lamb in his shops!!!
