Steers; All about the big boys in the gross catalogue with heavy finished Steers totting up. Top in the ppk a super U- Limousin Steer from Frank Hodgkin returning to the fold to take 249p/kg with another 244p/kg for full weight and every kilo fed. Hillside farm returned a South Devon R grade with a thick loin to take 225p/kg whilst weight from proper feeding saw R grades to 220p/kg from P R Mann & Son, Ufton at 789kg. Lightweight R Grades from N Webb, Badby saw 221p/kg and others from Hillside 219p/kg. R Grades all over 210p/kg today for anything scaling under 800kg. Weight though pays the bills and a marvellous £1773 for 844kg from P R Mann & Son, Ufton started the run that followed at £1752, £1736, £1723, £1722 and £1622. F Hodgkin £1644.

Heifers:

Everyone wants the Heifers.... Top today a proper U grade at birth and fed expertly to U+ from Josh Trivett, Atherstone who took weight and price at 255.5p/kg with a sister at 249p/kg. AA Fyfe & Sons, Yelvertoft saw 235.5p/kg and Parry Walters kept up his good form at 234.5p/kg. R Grades selling 228.5p/kg from Parry for fully fed meat with others 228p/kg. Other R Grades saw 227p/kg and 226p/kg from AG & SA Clarke, Nuneaton whilst Alan Tacy cought a nose bleed at 225p/kg for an expertly bred R Grade heifer. Gross Column again good reading with £1694 and £1666 from Josh Trivett whilst £1419 from Parry Walters and £1373 from Messrs Fyfe. Please more of the same with the live ring the only place to showcase the 'Swans' of the herd.

A smaller yarding with road closures playing havoc and approximately 300 booked in not making it through. An Sqq of 303p/kg a real trade with quality poor today with a lot of clear up lots or indeed Rare breeds on display. Best-end in short supply and perhaps also a steadier trade on the week with reports of Hoggs in excess of £9p/kgdw delivered into Belgium. Top today in the Export weights at 379p/kg with 38.5kg from L Smart, Cheltenham. K Crabtree saw 378p/kg at 41kg, 374p/kg at 39kg and 40kg to 365p/kg. H Reynolds saw nice shape to 36kg at 36q1p/kg. 45kg to 360p/kg from Messrs K Crabtree. In the heavies meat at a premium selling to 311p/kg at 46kg from LJD & JP Bolton, Windsor. V R Phipps showed meat and shape to 47.5kg at 305p/kg equal with L Smart, Cheltenham. In the lump Export Hoggs taking a top of £162 at 45kg from K Crabtree who also sold to £155 at 41kg whilst 38.5kg from L Smart took £146. Overall weight wanted and plenty selling north of £140 albeit no extra money in general for weight over 55kg with such bodies hard to process. Top overall today £166 at 75kg from J & R Lowe. L Smart saw £160 and H L Goode & Son 76kg to £159 and Messrs Bolton 61.5kg to £155. Trade today very buoyant but quality slipping, Meat needed.

This week the wagons rolling from the South East Coast last week from the South West. Top today saw RAE Wilson & Son with Texel to £180 ahead of Alison Pittom with Ewes to £178 and J & H Tustian Beltex to £170. Texel Ewes with strength to £165 from Greenfields of Twycross. Weight and meat the deciding factor seeing Suffolks in large pens to £165 from LJD & JP Bolton. Today all weighted white faces trading over £140 with only the very light under £120. Suffolks generally all £130 upwards with many over £140. Mules topping at £131 from Lee Bolton, Windsor and general trading £114 to £125 unless very lean. Romneys to £125 for large pens full from R Goodman up from Ashford. Trade completely unsustainable but a wonderful day for farmers whilst National Supplies are low.




