The annual Martinmas attracting a ring full of buyers with new faces around the ring and nice to see so many long distance travellers.

A few Cow & Calf units to begin with seeing 2018 Simmental Cows with Blue Calves 2 months of age selling to \pm 1850 and \pm 1720.

Young Cattle often harder to fix at this fixture but the hardened stock, a result of the last months weather, found favour with feeders. Young Simmental Bulls 9 months from Ibbetson & Crawley saw £850 with 11 month old sisters £815. Bucket calves done very well by Parke End Farming, Crick saw Angus in pens of 7 take Yearling Steers to £915 and sisters £740. Next in the annual sale of pure strength and quality from S & J Farming. These super strong Calves made £1250, £1175 x 5 £1150x 2 and £1145 x 5 for 9 to 11 month Charolais Steers and sisters £1045. Those of the same breeding and Autumn born saw Steers 14 months of age to £1305. A super show from a good farming family. H Lawton & Son, Market Bosworth took Angus 14 month Steers to £920 and sisters £815 with yearling South Devon Steers £855. Bevin & Co showed stock with scope selling a trio of Angus Heifers at 14 months to £980. A first appearance in this venue for the Gosling Family, Hinckley finding great favour with buyers all around the ring. Starting at £1225 for Simmental Steers 14 months the next at 14 to 17 £1215 and £1210 and yearlings £1140 and £1005. Sisters saw a pen of 5 to £1085. TH Morris showed the next generation moving the job forward when selling Simmental Heifers at £1185 21 months and £1120 at 19 months. Limousin the same £1060. PD & C Davenport, Banbury perhaps stealing the show with Blondes that dispelled the hard finishing rumours to show size and strength Steers 18 months saw £1290 and a trio £1255 before 21 and 22 months £1385 and £1355 others £1245 and £1230. Heifers the order of the day though to see 22 month Blondes to £1420 and 21 months £1400... Super Cattle!. Pete 'the champ' Warden fresh from his suckled calf success sold Angus Steers 14 months to £1090. An annual consignment from Kath Attfield, Leicester seeing year on year improvement. This year seeing 24 month Angus to £1325 20-23 months to £1200 and younger 18 months £1260. Older 24 month Steers saw £1265 with Bucket reared Angus £1185 23 months Lims and Blues all £1170 17 to 21 months. Sisters saw a pen of 4 to £1170 at 19 months with Blues £1190 and £1145. AA Day 19 month Limousin to £1140. M Lee, Clifton always has a good Martinmas show seeing 19 months in pens of 6 to £1130 and sisters £1120 and £1110.
