A nice yarding of Cattle but not such quality with the O grades and grass fed all on parade. Trade though fantastic with Wholesalers all out in force to chase for meat with Farmers now holding the key to the Beef food Chain.

Steers:

Much more quality than we have seen and some real shape on show selling to 272p/kg for G R Fountaine & Son whom sold heavier goods to 266p/kg. U Grades chased and nice finish from Frank Osbourne 262p/kg with U- 247p/kg. R Grades seeing better finish today and climbing into the mid 230's regularly. Top gross £1765 from Messrs Fountaine with PC Nichols £1723. Messrs Caswell and Nichols also placing numerous cattle in the £1600 plus club.

Heifers;

Dominated by the Natives but finish well rewarded throughout seeing proper Shop Heifers from P Jarrom to 265p/kg and 263.5p/kg for U Grades whilst F Osbourne took 255p/kg. R Grades getting upto the 240p/kg mark as Butchers compete for finish with O Grades high 230's mark. In the lump Cattle totting up to £1588 from Frank Hodgkin purchased by Mutchmeats Ltd, Witney. Cattle pursued throughout and buyers looking to fill Artics.

Bull; U1 Blonde Bulls at 15 months from LA & MA Holtom saw 240p/kg and £1522 selling to Ralph Pearson Wholesale Meats, Bradford. Many many more easily handled.

Cows;

Despite deadweight drops of 5p no ill affects here today. R Grade Hereford to 163p/kg and 162p/kg with O Grades to 160p/kg. Top gross £1280 from D J Hull & Partners. Stock Bulls a little smaller in frame this week but selling to 136p/kg for Limousin from F Hodgkin and 130p/kg for British Friesian from Border Holdings UK Ltd.

SPRING LAMBS:1814 FORWARD SQQ 247P/KG AVG £107

Over the 1800 mark but Vendors searching high and low for meat as weaning and weather dictates a slow in production. As reported nationally a two tier varding with fed meat weighing and selling well but a sudden influx of shelly lambs short on back finish. An Sqq of 247p/kg representing a very favourable return for producers. Best end on fire and selling to 345p/kg and 340p/kg from DJ Leadbeater with Pure Texels at 40 to 45kg. Export quality and finish saw MJ Woodward top at 38kg 297p/kg with other little barrels of meat 33.5kg to 296p/kg. Overnight shape from FH Everett & Son, Cherington saw 296p/kg whilst weighted Export Lambs 44kg at 286p/kg. Meated Export lambs under 43kg regularly 260 to 280p/kg with 43kg to 46kg trading at reduced rates of circa 230 -245p/kg dependant on quality. Heavies out in numbers today and reaching a very fast and competitive trade from start to finish. 47kg today trading to 298p/kg for Messrs Leadbeater with Big John Barnett 46.5kg to 285p/kg and 49.5kg 283p/kg. P F Edwards 48kg to 271p/kg and a super show of lambs from Stimson Farming Ltd seeing 56kg to 268p/kg. lots of little lambs in the averages today but still a yarding returning an all in avg of £107. Export Lambs totting up to a massive £153 for 45kg from Messrs Leadbeater with 40kg £138 and Stimson Farming, Stoke Bruerne 44kg to £126. S M Ellingworth 44kg to £124 and Stimson Farming 43kg to £122.50. Overall heavies well contested throughout as demand outstrips supply seeing a top of £150 at 56kg from Stimson Farming whilst 58kg from PC & RA Nichols took £149 and Stimson Farming 57kg to £142. P & LA Gibbs saw Jenny show massive quality and weight to 57kg at £142. Lambs a continued bewildering trade and buyers fit for quality throughout. Please though watch for daggings as we have had rejections by FSA in the last 24 hours. Please do not be the one that results in a buyer trading elsewhere on a Monday. Present Lambs clean enough to pass Anti-Mortem.

Home baking - Fruit Cake

Ingredients:

10oz (275g) currants

6oz (175g) sultanas

6oz (175g) raisins

4oz (100g) glace cherries, quartered

4oz (100g) ready to eat apricot, snipped into pieces

2oz (mixed candied peel, finely chopped

3 tablespoons brandy

8oz (225g) plain flour

1/4 teaspoon grated or dried nutmeg

1/2 teaspoon mixed spice

8oz (225g) soft margarine or softened butter

8oz (225g) dark muscovado sugar

4 large eggs

2oz (50g) whole almonds, chopped

1 scant tablespoon black treacle

grated rind of 1 lemon

grated rind of 1 orange

To finish:

Brandy to feed

Method:

Begin this cake the night before you want to bake it. Measure the prepared fruits into a large bowl, mix in the brandy, cover and leave in a cool place over night.

Pre-heat the oven to $140^{\circ}/275^{\circ}$ F/Gas 1. Grease and line an 8in (20cm) deep round cake tin with a double layer of greased greaseproof paper.

Measure the flour, spices, margarine or butter, sugar, eggs, almonds, treacle, lemon and orange rinds into a large bowl. Beat well to mix thoroughly, then fold in the soaked fruits. Spoon the mixture into the prepared tin and spread out evenly with the back of a spoon.

Cover the top of the cake loosely with a double layer of greaseproof paper.

Bake in the pre-heated oven for about $4-4\frac{1}{2}$ hours or until the cake feels firm to the touch and a skewer inserted into the centre comes out clean. Allow the cake to cool in the tin.

When cool, pierce the cake at intervals with a fine skewer and feed with a little brandy. Wrap the completely cold cake in a double layer of greaseproof paper and again in foil and store in a cool place for up to 3 months, feeding a t intervals with more brandy.

Leave undecorated.
