# WET DIRTY HOGGS THE ONLY HARD TO SELL ON A DAY WHEN THE YARD AVERAGED £107 ph DESPITE 24% weighing under 39kg.....

1100 penned the night before as vendors tried to negate the effects of Storm Dennis, and seemingly a sensible decision with the only lambs sticky to sell being wet and dirty Hoggs with buyers keen to kill on the day and complaining that the FSA may likely close production lines down for wet dirty sheep. An Sqq of 253p/ kg across 2433 Hoggs a very swift trade with buyers taking numbers throughout and in all honesty not the flashiest show of Hoggs this week. A real days trading but in all honesty a feeling that price today had started to reach a level beyond the comfort of Abbatoirs with the first signs of resistance on display. Best export lambs in short supply and breaking 300p/kg again today selling to 339p/kg for 44kg from Norfolk vendor Mr R F Woolhall with Beltex, the same vendor 36.5kg at 315p/k and 44.5kg at 312p/kg. SLAM Farming saw 41kg at 295p/kg with S Ellingworth, Kimcote 41.5kg at 294p/kg and J Wallis, Blakesley 291p/kg. Into the Heavies and Norfolk again top spot seeing 46kg at 287p/kg. Henry Tustian started off his season to see 48kg at 270p/kg with D Herrick, 46kg 265p/kg. Trade for shape all the way up the weight with Beltex from Keith Crabtree, Winslow at 261p/kg for 49.5kg. In the lump Export weights totting up today to see £149 at 44kg for overnight dry lambs from Mr Woolhall with 44.5kg at £139. Messrs Ellingworth saw 41.5kg at £122 and SLAM Farming 41kg at £121. Heavies probably the trade of the day for quality seeing weighted sheep totting up throughout. J K Smith & Son showed weight this week to 65kg and £142 whilst Bristol travellers A C Cook boasted dry clipped sheep to take £141,£140 x 2 for 67 to 62.5kg to leave the consignment of 125 Hoggs avg £132 at 57kg. Trade very smart and only wet lambs a real issue but vendors should now monitor trade as it looks likely to slow. This week light lambs on fire, this may also steady and vendors are advised to make sure lambs are fully finished for the next fortnight.
