A similar number forward to last week as we battle to ensure we hold back numbers to suit demand Lighter Export lambs reaching a good trade, while heavies struggle as numbers come out nationally. In the euros a top PPK of 244 for 41kg from Pete Batchelor and 36kg from Henry Tustian, both for Beltex. Pete struck again seeing 239ppk for 38.5kg and 44kg both for Beltex. Texel x from MR Cross saw 238ppk at 38kg. In the heavies a top ppk of 205 for Rocky and Rita Poulson with posh Charollais at 47.5kg. MFH Farming sold 46kg Texels to 203ppk, with Stuart Wise seeing 201ppk for his 46.5kg Texels. RHE Levinge sold 45.5kg Texel x to 196ppk with the same weights from Passmore Brothers, Aylesbury seeing 195ppk. In the lump the Euros topped by Pete Batchelor with 44kg Beltex to £105, with 41kg to £100 and 38.5kg to £92. FH Everett & Son sold 43kg Charollais x to £91.50 with Beltex x from R Richins seeing £91.50 for 42.5kg. Top price per head for the Poulsons today seeing £110 for £58kg Charollais, with FJ Tombs & Son selling £58.5kg Texels to £100. Stanley Colinswood sold 60.5kg Charollais x to £99, with 47.5kg from the Poulsons to £97.50 and 60kg Suffolk x to £96 from A Tarry-Smith. In truth, the best show of sheep since Christmas. Lighter lambs seeing more enquiry as numbers go tighter, while to over supply of heavies nationwide holding the trade low.
