CATTLE: 81 Forward

PRIME CATTLE :47 HEAD

An increased entry number-wise, saw the 'Dairy Day' influx in the entry, with a large percentage dairy bred. Talk all week had been of the large drops in price experienced in the deadweight sector and waiting lists to get into Abattoirs, serious amount of cheap box meat available. However the strength of the live auction came to the fore with 10 men at ringside, competing for all types, at admittingly less money in all sections, but trade is trade.

BULLS: 12 HEAD

The continued buyers support at ringside, finally saw a decent entry number-wise on offer, the majority been dairy- bred animals from the best to poor-shaped. The 'Dairy day' show was judged by Mr. Jack Gilder who went about his business in an able manner, and gave the prize to a Belgium Blue X from Steven Abbott which went on to top the sale at 170p with brothers 167p. Fleck Crosses sold to 143p from Dawson Partnership. Top price per head was £963.59 from Highfield Farm. More Bulls are required on a weekly basis.

STEERS:20 HEAD

Increased numbers, containing everything in the entry, lightweights, heavyweights, quality continentals to very working class dairy types, but all met buyer competition and were well sold on the trade. A superb run of Limousin's from Messrs Hopkins of Lutterworth topped the section at 203p and averaged 197p. Heavyweights sold regularly in the high 180's, with top price per head been £1355.75 for a superb Blonde from Steven Webster. Dairy types topped at 167p for a Holstein from Geoff and Sue who sold others to 159p. Very plain dairy- types sold between 96-120p, and looked the dearest of all.

HEIFERS:15 HEAD

Good numbers, easily handled at ringside saw as ever, butcher types good to sell, whilst others have to be quoted easier. Parry Walters had a good weekend, Wales achieved the Grand Slam and his load of heifers topped the Sale and Section at 208p with a Limousin, Bazadaise Crosses sold to 200p from Geoff and Sue with a stylish handyweight. Heavyweights sold to £1275.04 from Clifton, with others £1248.45 the same.

OTM's, AND COWS: 15 HEAD

Extremely varied entry, saw buyers keen for everything, in particular second quality types which benefitted from the seven buyers operating. The section was topped at 168p. for an Angus Steer from Mr. McNally, heifers sold to 149p, from D.P.Jones. Cows sold to 123p for a continental from Richard Ellis, with aged Angus's to 120p from Robert Bryson. The judge, Mr. Jack Gilder, found his 1st Prize dairy cow in a young black and white from Mr. Phil Dyson which sold to 116p which grossed £841.60, Top price per head was £1016.40 from Fair Haven, with others £1014.69.

Prime Hoggs: 1676 Forward SQQ 203p/kg

Numbers becoming harder to find as we swap over to the feeding men. Today either Hoggs from early draw feeding men or clearings ups from whole life farmers. An Sqq of 203p/kg representing a lift in trade with middle weights harder to sell than in recent weeks and the averages only limited by some O-4H Hoggs in the alleys. Trade swift throughout albeit buyers complaining about slow sales and hard trading climates across the water and at home. Supply though seemingly tightening to help trade. In the Handyweights light Hoggs very dear. Beltex top from Henry Tustian to 231p/kg for 37.5kg with equal weights from Dabba Mitchell 227p/kg. Similar bred Hoggs to 45kg from DS & LE Wadland 224p/kg and Pete Batchelor 222p/kg twice for 36.5kg. Export Hoggs upto 31kg almost all exclusively 205p/kg plus with 190 Hoggs selling over 210p/ kg. In the heavies top of 215p/kg at 47kg for Beltex from J & H Tustian Root Hoggs whilst DS & LE Wadland 51kg to 213p/kg and Humphrey Livestock 46kg to 208p/kg. In the lump Hoggs in the handyweight range topping out at £101 at 45kg from Messrs Wadland. DJ & EM Fountain, Long Buckby saw 45kg to £90.50 equal with Messrs Tustian and Humphrey Livestock. Heavies a world of difference today with demand for weight back and insofar as they are not over fat. Top today £117 for a 59kg from David Wadland ahead of H L Goode & son £112, £111, £110 with Messrs Wadland £106.50 and £109. Trade responding to national numbers but very little extra demand.

Dirty Hoggs – Today the reputation of our vendors let down with vendors intending on selling Hoggs in an absolutely filthy state. One Hogg carrying nearly 3kg of muck on its tail. These hoggs cannot be killed. Moving forward dirty Hoggs will be reported to trading standards and Hoggs needing clipping on the morning of sale charged at £1 per Hogg. The current state of Hoggs presented for sale is not acceptable.


