Prime Lambs: 2605 Forward SQQ 196p/kg

Up goes the trade and out come the numbers with just over 2700 lambs today, and in truth a very poor show of quality with the weather showing its effects and some very lean poor lambs put forward. That said a SQQ of 196p/kg representing a good return well ahead of deadweight comparison, trade though noticeably calmer than the week before as an influx of lambs hit the national trade. 196p/kg at 46% represents a deadweight of 4.26p/kgdw. Trade therefore without compare to the deadweight especially with the number of lambs O 2 grade or less today. Quality as rewarded and best end lambs remain in high demand. In the Export weight lambs a top of 300p/kg for a freak of a Beltex from N Walker, Burford at 30kg with a similar sort from Laban Partners at 245p/kg. T M Paton & Sons, Milton Keynes showed 40kg to 233p/kg. SLAM Farming 231p/kg on two occasions. Today 465 lambs trading over the 200p/kg mark. Trade for meat throughout the weights seeing 46kg to 204p/kg from Di Hopcraft with 46.5kg from the same 201p/kg and overnight lambs from JCB Farms 46kg to 200p/kg. In the lump Euro lambs popping away at £94.50 at 45.5kg for R Deeley with Katherine Attfield, Willoughby Waterleys 45kg to £93.50. TM Paton & Sons 40kg to £93 and B C Burton 42kg at £92.50. Heavies topping the trade seeing £107 for 56kg from RF & J Nichols ahead of Humphrey Livestock £106 for 56kg and BMF Smith £103 for 61kg on two occasions. Today 520 lambs trading over £90!!

Trade now being hit by large numbers coming onto the market. This should be monitored in the coming weeks albeit today a large Supermarket processor in the aisles for the first time this year perhaps showing numbers on the deadweight drying up.

A handy number with farmers now through the pre tupping back log as they now turn all viable females to the Tup. Trade remains buoyant with buyers selling Ewe meat not at any great shakes but in a sustainable manner leading upto the likely Christmas uplift. £119 top for a Texel Tup today from Stuart Wise with Ewes to £112 from R C Hawes equal with Tups from Robert Davy and S Wise. Texel Ewes to £100 from Messrs Hawes and Bettles with most trading in the £90 region. Suffolks short on size today but trading to £90 from Messrs Tombs & Son with most mid eighties. Mules remain strong operating in mid £60 region topping at £85 for T G White, Stratford upon Avon. Mules trade likely to drop in coming weeks and vendors warned that Fat Ewes are very hard to shift of whatever breed.

A better top end of the entry and a much worse bottom end, however all that irrelevant with trade simply put, ON FIRE. Top today to £82 from WG Batchelor & Son for Texel x, with Sam Gibbs to £80 for Suffolks. Short keep pounds dearer today between £73 and £80 with the best end of the medium lambs well up in the £68-£70 bracket. Colder medium sorts actively £60-£65 with the harder bred around the £55. Only the very small or rare bred dropping under £50.

Arthers to £945. Angus Steers sold to £1000 at 19 months from R Roots, Leicester with others £990. As we moved into the aged cattle quality markedly improves and Ringer Farms was high as a kite with his trade as he set us off at £1100 for 22 month old Angus Steers whilst 18 month Blonde Steers to £1025 and others £1000 with sisters £955 and £950. A wonderful run from Kirsty Badger starting with the genuine leaner well bred Stores at £1080 17 months for Limousin Steers with others £1060. Weighted Steers with more finish £1090 whilst longer keep sized Steers £1050 to £1005. Heifers to £920 at 16 months and £905. Smart Angus from R J Wright to £1070 at 15 month and others at 17 months the same with Steers £1020. BP

Farms showed traditional grazed Angus at 18 months to £1060 with sisters £1045. Perhaps trade of the day to bucket reared Simmentals from Ian Sharlot at 24 months to £1090 with big pens of Herefords £1070 and Blue Heifers £1035 at 21 months. Messrs Webb Towcester £1010 for Simmentals at 19 months with sisters £995 whilst M Lee £1065 for 20 month old Limx Steers. Robinson Bros, Market Harbrough showed Stabilisers to £1000 20 months before smart goods from OJ & MJ Guest showed 19 month Steers, Blue Charolais £1090 with others £1050, good white Charolais Steers from F H Sherratt to £1100. Annual consignments from R Ellis saw Angus to £1160 and £1150 for pens full at 20 months with Sisters to £1100 in pens of 6. Limousins from the same saw Steers at £1145 with sisters £1050. Strong

Trade must be reported as strong for genuine Store Cattle and perhaps the dearest trade for the right goods we have seen in a couple of years. Finally some optimism

Shorthorns from GM & LD Robson for a pen of 4 at 23 to 24 months.

The annual sale once again attracting plenty of attention with the noticeable point this year the number of Northern Buyers travelling down to see what was on offer. A yarding that was very mixy, with a wealth of poor bred Store cattle in the aisles in comparison to past years. That said some real genuine annual consignments also on show. We started with grazing cows and aged Cow Units seeing Hereford Cows and Calves to £900 from D Tallis. Young cattle a hard sell with quality short but Suckled calves to £770 at 9 months for Simmentals from Elms Farm with others from Messrs

Lovett, Derbyshire seeing Blondes at £720 for 6 months. Quality rewarded and Clarke Farming Partnership, Steeple Aston saw 11 month Charolais to £930 before D Brown, Flore sold 15 month South Devons to £850. The annual consignment from RAJ & D Hopkins saw plenty of interest only tempered by them showing a few less this year. The Families genuine Stores saw Charolais Steers in pens of 5 to £1075 at 18 months with others £1050 and £1005. Limousins to £1005 and £990. Sisters took £975 and £950 for Charolais with Limousin to £940. Equal age Unassured Lincoln Reds from the Morley Family to £910 and 17 month Limousin from John
