## **CATTLE: 166 FORWARD**

A nice yarding of exactly 100 today met a trade that perhaps had the edge off the trade albeit only slightly. Competition reigned supreme and trade meeting a level for quality.

### **Steers;**

Proper finish on display if not the superstars of recent weeks. Top 264p/kg p/kg for weighted cattle from TV & J Kennealy ahead of Robert Mitchell Farms with shapely Steers to 260p/kg and smart meated U- from F A Osbourne to 257p/kg. O+ Cattle into the 230's. In the lump £1775 and £1732 for TV & J A Kennealy with E J Taylor £1679. And F Hodgkin £1657.

### **Heifers;**

Not the quality we have seen and generally only R grades at the top end selling to 260p/kg for a U- from F Hodgkin with 255p/kg for R Grades from Messrs Fountaine & Son. Handy Shapes a little leaner from P Jarrom to 255p/kg and 251p/kg. O+ Grades to well towards 240p/kg. In the lump a top of £1784 for F Hodgkin with £1647 and £1628 from R Ellis & Son with Angus.

### **Bulls;**

An assortment of O+ grade Bulls today selling to 220p/kg for meat Bulls from Alan Tacy with Angus. Heavy Herefords from I Markham to 212p/kg and £1604.

### **Cows;**

The edge off slightly on the Cows as processor switch works to Clean cattle for December preparations. Trade though equal to well over 308p/kg dw equivalent . Meat reigning supreme seeing 170.5p/kg for aged Cows on the R from Messrs Hull with Herefords from the same to 159p/kg and Angus 164p/kg. O+ almost all over 148p/kg save as for those showing age and starting to lose meat from their backs. Top gross saw Herefords to £1393 and £1329 from Hull Farms. OTM; a few running 30 to 36 months of age selling to 234p/kg and 220p/kg from Messrs Lee & Son returning £1655.

Trade resulted in a stand on level at 244p/kg albeit a large number of middle weights 43 to 45kg today short on meat falling between two differing demands. In truth a very reasonable trade with all accounts wanting stock. Best end lambs well sort after and chased throughout. Top today some small but full finished Beltex from Will Young at 32.5kg to 329p/kg ahead of a proper Beltex at 44kg to 314p/kg from Messrs Bevin. Will Young also 37.5kg to 309p/kg and Kieth Crabtree 43kg to 300p/kg. P F Edwards 39.5kg to 286p/kg. Heavies continue as a real trade throughout topping at 49kg to 290p/kg with 48kg to 275p/kg from P F Edwards. Smart weighted 52kg from Will Young saw 272p/kg and plenty of weighted lambs over 260p/kg. Today an all in of £110 to include a lot of small City trade lambs pulled from the Store Aisles to meet a specific demand. Export weights still totting up well at £138 for 44kg with 43kg to £129 for Keith Crabtree and £124 for 45kg from AEJ & FJ Claridge selling the same to £122 also. Heavies a real trade and pen after pen breaking £130 barrier. RF & J Nichols saw 55kg to £145 and W & M Emery & Son saw 57kg £143 with K Crabtree smart 49kg to £142. 52kg to £142 from FJ Tombs with the usual crowd pleasers and WO Young £141.50. Today anything with weight and meat all well ahead of £138 throughout. Trade just remains on a flow and long may it last. Vendors please though strive to ensure finish as many today short of proper feeding.
