Numbers restricted and tailored to meet demand and we got it about right with trade just falling away towards the end. Sales slow nationally and a very poor deadweight quote showing little sign of moving. An SQQ of 194p/kg miles ahead of comparison to any deadweight option. Light lambs hard to sell but that said the best shape on show generally small lambs but just fitting the requirements for our two Continental Accounts. Top today 254p/kg for Beltex from Jean Herod at 37kg with PD & DM Hopcraft 225p/kg for smart 41.5kg. P F Edwards, Stratford Upon Avon 36 and 34kg at 222p/kg. Heavies very much the same, with best end rewarded selling to 221p/kg at 46kg from RHE Levinge, Staines on Thames whilst Buckinghams own AEJ & FJ Claridge 49kg at 220p/kg and 47kg 210p/kg and 46.5kg at 208p/kg. Meat and finish rewarded throughout with a top gross in the Euro weight section of £94 at 37kg from J Herod with others £94 at 45kg from Mark Lambert. Top today 267 lambs grossing over £90. Top today £127 for Smart Texels from Slapton Manor at 68kg with 66kg £110from R & B Smith, Towcester selling to the revisiting Yorkshire Wholesalers. AEJ & FJ Claridge 49kg to £108.


