Top to Page Bros with clear up Beltex at 35kg to 214p/kg with Parkinson Partners, Sheepy Magna 211p/kg and 210p/kg for Texels at 39.5kg and 40kg. Claire Colegrave travelled up from Cheltenham with 350 or so to take 209p and 206p/kg for super light at 33kg. Today 110 Hoggs over 200p/kg. In the heavies a top ppk of 189p/kg for R Goodman at 48kg for Charollais whilst 46.5kg from S Deeming saw 187p/kg with F C Knight 186p/kg at 47.5kg. Overall Euro section Hoggs topped in the gross at £87 for 42.5kg from Will Moore with N Barratt £86.50 for 43.5kg and Richard Fountaine equal with Charollais at 45kg.
