A few more Cattle about and on the whole most of them oddities. A 3p drop on the deadweight last week places shade across the Cattle industry but this trade showed merely that demand for quality outstrips supply.

Quality really well wanted today and even the poor end stuff a good trade in comparison to the alternative. In the Steers no real show stoppers but good meat from R W Cross & Partners 197p/kg ahead of Terry Kennealy at 188p/ kg although weight paying with T E Barnacle at £1303 for a Blue Steer at 27 months. R Grades high 180p/kg.

Heifers wanted and quality taking the rewards with AEJ & FJ Claridge topping with a weighted Limousin Heifer at 226p/kg ahead of Parry Walters at 223p/kg and Richard Grindal at 218p/kg. Top gross to Messrs Claridge at £1323 with Parry Walters at £1316. R Grades trading all around the 200p/kg mark.

Quite simply good Cattle wanted and the only sticking point the wealth of cheap boxed meat on the market.

Cows and Breeding Bulls the trade of the day. Grade 2 Cows to follow oceans of weight at 160p/kg and 886kg for a Limousin Cow from Messrs J & IJ Tivey returning £1418. Grade 3 Cows to 134p/kg for Blues with Black and Whites to 131p/kg. Grade 4 Cows over 92p/kg. JK Smith & Sons showed two aged Simmental Stock Bulls to 105p/kg.

A small but mighty show! Perhaps not in quality the mighty part, but a mighty trade with Blonde x Heifers from G Poutney to £295 whilst Sussex Bull Calves to \pounds 76 and Black and Whites to \pounds 70.

SHEEP: 2,810 forward

Prime Hoggs: 2,070 forward SQQ 195.5p/kg

Numbers harder to find this week with root men reporting Hoggs struggling to catch meat. We did though still yard well over 2,000 Hoggs. Noticeable though today that guality on two stages. Some really well finished sorts and some Hoggs sold underweight and before their time. A marvellous trade though with an SQQ of 195.5p/kg seemingly the highest of the days trading with a National slow reported around as reports of New Zealand deliveries now docking. Second rate goods, especially in the Euro spec perhaps a little harder to sell but with an overall average of 188p/kg plenty of demand for heavier cutting Hoggs. In the Euro spec a top today to Pete Batchelor at 223p/ kg for 37kg Beltex with 40kg at 220p/kg. A & T Shaw travelling down from Hints to take 218p/kg at 39.5kg for Texels. 356 Hoggs trading over 200p/kg. In the heavies a top ppk of 207p/kg for Jack Lombard with 46kg Charollais whilst Messrs Shaw pulled the same trick off with weight also to take 202p/kg at 49kg whilst Dave King came up with quality at 200p/kg for 46kg. Gross figures counting today with 670 Hoggs at £90 or more!! In the lump Euro Hoggs topped at £92 for 44.5kg from Messrs Shaw ahead of his close rivals Messrs White Bros, Tamworth at £91 for 45.5kg and David Shipton at £89 for 44kg. Overall a top today for Henry Tustian seeing heavies at 61kg to £115. Henry showed today a load of 114 Hoggs to return an average of £93.30!! 73kg Cheviots from Gate Farming saw £108 with 62kg from the same £106 tied with Jack Lombard who had £106 for a pen full of 67.5kg. A good days trading again with competition and honesty the key here. I have mentioned sustainability of the Hogg trade for some weeks and must express the need to monitor the trade in the coming days as a indicator of the mid term outlook.
