Can I please remind people of the belly clipping service on Sunday nights which allows buyers to bid with confidence. Just a few complaints from abattoirs this week of dirty bellies and Hoggs needing crutching out. We do weigh every bit of your Hoggs but please help buyers to feel assured they are buying meat not muck. Trade today frankly better than expected and again likely in the top three trades for the day. An SQQ of 195.13p/kg miles ahead of the deadweight and frankly a super return when considering the number of leaner Hoggs shown today. Top of the Euro section this week to A & T Shaw with smart Beltex to 215p/kg for 39kg whilst B F Humphrey & Son saw 208p/kg for Beltex at 42.5kg. S J Cartwright Ltd, Griff and R J Osborn & Son both 206p/kg at 40kg. Today 160 Hoggs trading over 200p/kg. In the Heavies a top p/kg of 212p/kg for a super Beltex at 50kg from Dave Mitchell, Grendon. R Goodman saw 208p/kg for 45.5kg Beltex and R Randall & Son saw 200p/kg for 51kg. Overall the Euro section topped at £89.50 for 45kg Texels from C Sagent and R Woodward. BF Humphrey & Son had £88.50 twice for 42.5kg & 44kg Beltex. 
