An SQQ of 188p/kg well ahead of returns at the end of last week and undoubtedly some way ahead of deadweight comparison. Trade therefore a pleasing outcome and despite the unforeseen strengthening of the pound over the weekend and poor Continental meat sales. Some smart lambs forward today, as well as some that had taken the weather very badly. In the Euro section a top of 213 and 211p/kg for 37kg Beltex from FJ Clarke ahead of Charollais from new vendor R Hicks with 211p/kg for 36.5kg. 38kg from F & J Clarke to 207p/kg and 40kg from W B Wrench 203p/kg equal with CBE Price for 38kg. 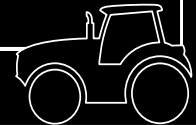
