A grade 2 Limousin from Richard Ellis which would die well sold to a marvellous 179p/kg returning £1236. Grade 3 Cows from J North & Son sold to 140p/kg twice with others 132p/kg and 129p/kg. Even screw Cows shaking the pound mark and so far ahead of the dead it is untrue. A smart aged Stock Bull from P L Morris, Aylesbury met a swift trade for his Limousin at 993kg returning £1371 at 138p/kg.

Top though for the day to Messrs Lea seeing Charolais Steers at 20 months of age take £1200. A smart trade just another 200 Cattle short.

Spring Lambs: 2,536 forward SQQ 200.44p/kg

The first outing following the weekends scare mongering following Brexit. Who would have thought it? It seems Europe does still want our lamb! An improved trade due to a favourable Euro exchange and buyers out in force. The SQQ today 200p/kg representing a real trade with some lambs showing the effects of the wet weather just hours before drawing. Buyers though clearly with orders to fill and the 2,500 plus lambs forward receiving a fast trade. In the Euro Section a top ppk today 220p/kg a four way draw for Rouge lambs at 220p/kg at 40kg from S Phillips, Tamworth also at 220p/kg on two occasions for WV Harris & Son, Henley in Arden whom sold a run of over 100 all of which to be proud of. 220p/kg also for Dave Mitchell with 39.5kg Beltex. Messrs Harris also 218p/kg twice for 38.5kg Charollais with Anne Wilson 217p/kg for 42kg Rouge. Today 250 lambs trading over 210p/kg. In the Heavies a top ppk of 205p/kg for 46kg from Alan Boffey whilst 202p/kg bought 49kg from MM Clarke & Son whilst R D Green sold 48.5kg Charollais to 200p/kg. In the lump Euro Lambs topped at £93 for 44kg Beltex for R & R Knowles, Leicester with MM Clarke & Son £91.50 for 45.5kg and Ann Wilson £91 for Rouge at 42kg. Overall top spot a draw between Brian Mawby and D W Guerny & Son both taking £102 for 55kg Charollais. DR & ME Kind £100 for 50.5kg. Trade quick today and the favourable exchange rate seemingly having a positive effect this end with market lambs responding to the upturn and perhaps 25p/kg deadweight dearer than the grid quotes.

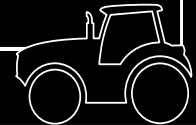
