Prime Lambs: 2,300 forward SQQ 190p/kg

A good yarding put together today as the Quarbani celebrations managed to clear a lot of number from across the nation last week. In truth a trade of exactly two halves. We set off at a trade well in advance of anything seen at the end of last week, as buyers tried to send lambs back to meet the last of the festivals demands. Mobile phones though rang and trade dropped upto 10p/kg to meet trade elsewhere. An Sqq though of 190p/kg the dearest in the nation and 15p up on the National Averages. In the Euro spec a top today of 211p/kg from A & R Rothen for lambs having been in the market all night at 35.5kg Texels ahead of P J Incley at 209p/kg for 43kg Texels with Showell Farms 42kg at 207p/kg. In the heavies some real trade and 210p/kg for the first pen of the day sold by Humphrey Livestock at 46kg with B Burton 208p/ kg at 46kg with Page Bros 206p/kg at 46.5kg for Charollais. Despite the slow in trade meated lambs wanted all the way through and trading at deadweight comparison of 415p/kg througout. In the lump Euro lambs topped at £92.50 for 43kg from Rory Long, P Incley 43kg at £90 Cecil Thomas Charollais x Lleyns £90 for 44.5kg, H L Goode £90 for 45kg and Pete Incley the same. Overall some real trade today with a top of £126 for a pair of none working Ram lambs from S Dunkley at 70kg whilst Beltex from P Batchelor 56.5kg at £114.50 with Robert and Jenny Nichols £106 at 56kg and 49kg Beltex from Pete Batchelor £100.

Trade must now be watched to see where we move forward through the post festival demand across Europe. Numbers though likely to slow nationally as lambs seemingly now not doing.
