As trade all around the country faded we too found a slow in trade but a full aisle of buyers ensured returns well ahead of comparison with an SQQ of 183p/kg. A trade made even more phenominal by the poor quality of meat on show today. Lean sheep and light lambs this year have seen less demand. This is even more highlighted at the moment as the Northern Whether lambs are drawn to do the lightweight job across the country.

Please draw meat and finish and the number of buyers at ringside will do the rest.

In the Euro lambs a top today of 206p/kg from Messrs Claridge, Buckingham for 44kg Beltex ahead of R m Seckington & Son at 203p/ kg and Will Moore, Leicester at 202p/kg. R M Seckington and T Young both taking 200p/kg. In the Heavies trade a little steadier today but still peaking at 198p/kg for 46kg and 193p/kg for 48kg from M Guest, Atherston. In the lump the Euro section topped today at £91 for 45kg from Will Moore. Messrs Claridge £90.50 for 44kg and Messrs Seckington £90 for 45kg. Overall a top of £107 today for Mrs Goulden, Northampton at 63kg. £103 for MM Clarke & Son at 57.5kg and £102 for W Haynes with 60kg with Roger Deeley £101.50 for 58.5kg.
