SHEEP: 3109**Prime Lambs 1557 forward SQQ 175p/kg**

Every effort made today to limit the yarding in response to last weeks poor returns around the country in all forms of lamb sales but despite this still well over 1500 sold today. Trade frankly much better than expected with buyers with genuine orders ready to fire from the off. The SQQ of 175p/kg whilst back on the week perhaps 5p better than the trade could have been anticipated. In fact one Wholesale buyer today leaving empty handed to return and buy lambs straight from the meat market trade as a cheaper alternative. Top spot today a tie between Frank Page and Dave Mitchell both with Beltex at 199p/kg at 45 and 43.5kg respectively. 198p/kg from Messrs Page and Messrs AEJ & FJ Claridge also at 43 and 40kg. In the heavies a top ppk of 183p/kg today to BC Burton at 47.5kg whilst J Fowkes 181p/kg at 47kg and R Woodward, Stratford Upon Avon 180p/kg at 50kg. In the lump Euro lambs a top of £87 for 45kg from Messrs Claridge, Page Bros £86.50 for 43.5kg and 45kg at £85. Overall top to S & J Farming at £93 for 63kg with R Woodward twice £90 for 50 and 53kg. Trading again ahead of expectations but a tough time being seen by all exporters currently as financial frailties on the Continent seem to be coming to the fore.

As we moved up the ages quality appreciated and definite price difference dependant on quality with John Arthers showing 14 month old Steers to £1020 for Limousin and 13 months at £930 with 15 month heifers to £920. Then again up the ages to see £1020 for a Simmental Heifer from P Woodward at 19 months. 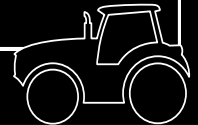
