A much better yarding in numbers although quality a little sparse. Trade though very brisk and anyone who has killed any direct recently would be able to tell you that the cattle today would average a minimum of £100 more through the ring than the alternative. In the Steers, a top today of 194p/kg for Angus Steers from SF & AJ Deeming returning £1358 whilst other Steers mainly plain sorts with R Grades up towards the 190p/kg mark.

Heifers saw a nice show topping at 216p/kg for Parry Walters ahead of CD Harrison at 214p/kg with a top gross of £1243 for a heavy Charolais from Messrs Osbourne. Today some O grades and less looking a real shot for Northern processors.

Just a couple but trade looking very brisk at 198p/kg for 657kg from Messrs Barnwell to return £1301.

#### Prime Lambs: 1494 forward SQQ 180p/kg

Just under 1500 yarded today as customers continue to appreciate consistency in marketing in this yard. Trade a sharp uplift from last weeks National returns albeit buyers reluctant to spend more due to tight margins over sale prices, but seemingly national slows in supply of lambs rendered buyers needing to buy today when the numbers are available to them. An SQQ today just shy of 180p/kg representing a significant lift on National returns and especially favourable considering that all the yard was wet through and lamb quality on the whole very poor. In the Euro section quality rewarded from Ken Evans selling Texels at 44kg to 200p/kg equal with Frankie Badger at 200p/kg for 36.5kg and G Doyle, Shipston on Stour 191p/kg. In the heavies the ppk a top of 188p/kg from Mr Evans, Ladbroke again with 48kg Texels whilst B C Burton 185p/kg for 47.5kg and 48kg Beltex. Meat and cover today in short supply and well rewarded. In the lump, Euro weight lambs topping at £88 for 44kg from Ken Evans with Dawn Mcmahon, Mancetter £84.50 for 44.5kg and £84 for 45kg from R & A Adams & Partners. Overall today, the lump dominated by properly fed lambs from BMF Smith selling £103 for 60kg, £99.50 & £99 for 58kg and £94, £93 for 54.5kg. H L Goode & Son £94 for 57kg. A very favourable days trading with returns greater than can be expected on the current red meat trade, but supply and demand forces again dictating the way ahead.
