## **CATTLE: 174 FORWARD**

A funny week with Abbatoirs either deciding to empty all fridges or those with extra demand for the New Year. A customer short but trade not effected. Meat in demand throughout and only very lean hard to handle.

#### Steers;

All big weighted Cattle in the main today topping at 237p/kg for R W Cross & Partners with heavy weights to 236p/kg from Messrs Keeves. Super Heavies throughout over 220p/kg. In the gross a top of  $\pm 1818$  for Messrs Keeves with others  $\pm 1760$  and  $\pm 1744$ .

#### Heifers;

Much more finish on show albeit no less weight at the top end. The two commodities coming together when super heavies with finish and grade from RF & J Nichols showed super feeding with a 742kg Charolais Heifer U graded at 285p/kg selling to D S Trading, Grimsby Ltd. Smart Heifers as always from the Trivetts this week with weight saw 276p/kg and 272.5p/kg. U Grades from Pete Amor showing plenty of finish returning 270p/kg. R Grades into the 250p/kg region if carrying flesh and O Grades well into 220p/kg plus mark. The lump seeing massive returns at £2160 and £2115. Messrs Trivett £1800.

#### Bulls;

More Bulls forward saw Bazadaise from P Amor to 249p/kg with others 245 and 230p/kg. Top gross  $\pm$ 1335.

#### OTM;

O Grade 40 month Limousin Steers to 205p/kg with a top gross £1333 from Alan Tacy.

#### Cows;

Thick Angus Cows up from the South for Red Kite Farming saw 167 and 164.5p/kg for slip Angus Heifers returning a top of £1094. Cows likely to be in greater demand in January albeit trade for Slip Cows today as keen as we have seen.

A Thank you to all those who have sold with us this year. The Board have taken the decision to push the Cattle section with all their Efforts and we hope you have reaped the rewards. Those who have sold have found returns preferable to the deadweight and this is ofcourse our mission statement. Best fed Cattle are too often undersold on the hook and we need these. ### PRIME LAMBS: 1834 FORWARD SQQ 293P/KG AVG £125

Report of Deadweight kill cancellations Nationally had some buyers back in the cars and heading off before we even started. Thankfully the Exporters didn't get the Memo and trade simply breath taking. Numbers a little shorter today as vendors struggle to find meat. The yard dominated by Export O Grade lambs but all massively rewarded with a deadweight equivalent of £6.30. Best end in massive demand today with not so much quality on show. Top saw real peach lambs from D Mitchell to 349p/kg at 35kg for Beltex with similar goods from G Woodard 335p/kg. S Taylor, Coventry sold Beltex to 334p/kg at 38kg with AEJ & FJ Claridge 39kg to 333p/kg. Humphrey Livestock with quality at 43kg to 330p/kg, and JP Page & Sons 44kg at 330p/kg. Heavy lambs very well chased despite fire sales on the Supermarket shelves. Top today a massive 323p/kg at 47kg from S Leedham, Husbands Bosworth with VJ Roots 52kg to 323p/kg for Beltex. Messrs Claridge 47kg to 311p/kg and Leam Farm Partnership 52kg to 306p/kg. The total column of course the one to keep the bank happy and Export weights back to doing the same. Top in the weight band seeing a top of £145 for 44kg from J P Page & Sons with Humphrey Livestock 43kg to £142 and B Nichols 44.5kg to £141. D Redfern down from Derby to take 45kg to £138.50. Heavies very much in vogue albeit those over 60kg getting no additional benefit for weight. They are just too heavy to handle it seems at the other end. Top though £168 for 52kg from V J Roots with 53kg from Amorise Farms Ltd also £168. D Dashwood £163 at 66kg with £162 for Suffolks from Humphrey Livestock the same selling to £161. FJ Tombs & Son £160 and £161.

Lamb trade the leading reason for the Auction system. Supermarkets cant sell it this week but Exporters can. Last week the opposite. What other systems reacts in real time? Our job is to supply independent buyers in numbers at ringside and hopefully we do that with today 10 men actively bidding on multiple accounts. Thank you for all your Vendor support this year and congratulations to all sheep farmers whom proved the 'experts' wrong during Brexit. They may undervalue your hard work but RFM does not and as proven neither do our European Customers.
