Numbers continue to come forward, with all sections seeing increases apart from the otm's. Several buyers at ringside were quieter with some abattoirs cancelling on the morning, due to slow sales. The auction system showed its strength with all classes a sharp trade ,in particular heifers which would be similar on the week.

A hard trade throughout and many buyers today only buying due to coercion. Unlike the local Abbatoir last week we cannot just lock the gates and have to find buyers in any case. In the euro weights a top of 281p/kg to 38.5kg from R & B Smith with 279p/kg from TH Morris & Sons at 38kg and P K Cobley 277p/kg at 39kg. In the heavies a top trade of 235p/kg for 45.5kg from R J Wright to 235p/kg with 47kg to 219p/kg from J & R Lowe.
