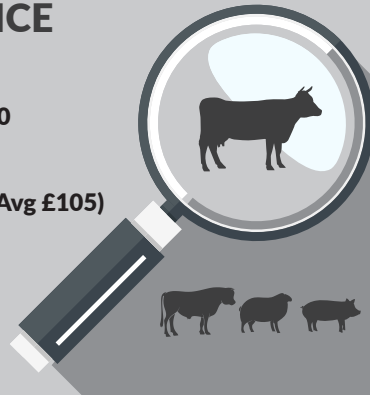

## CATTLE: 48 FORWARD



A reasonable yarding albeit no where near enough to cover demand at ringside. A yarding of mainly O+ Cattle which showed plenty of feeding and therefore fitting Wholesaler demand. The few Cattle on display grading over an R grade a royal trade and many more wanted.

### Steers;

Dominated by the heavyweights today seeing R Grade 720kg sell to 229p/kg with heavy lean Blondes from Alan Tacy to 228.5p/kg. R Grade Handyweights to 225.5p/kg from B Caswell, Northampton and 220p/kg from DJ Hull & Partners, Essex. O+ grades to 217.5p/kg from Messrs Hull. Weight pays and E J Taylor & Son taking £1650 and £1613 selling to Mutchmeats Limited.

### Heifers;

Full meated O+ grades finding favour with Buyers but the few shining lights of quality finding audience throughout the ring. Top today a U+/E Grade Blue Heifer with style and proper finish from S Daly, Rugby. This super meated Heifer at 652kg showed plenty of finish before falling at 273p/kg to Ralph Pearson Wholesale Butchers, Bradford. Smart shaped but leaner types from the same at Butchers weight 260.5p/kg. U- Limousin Heifers from CD Harrison & Sons saw 240p/kg with G R Fontaine heavy Heifers to 237.5p/kg R grades to 225p/kg equal with Messrs Fontaine. O+ to 220p/kg and O grades to 210p/kg. In the gross £1780 from S Daly with £1442 and £1420 to G R Fontaine & Son.

A hard pill for all to take, not only farmers and Auctioneers but also Abattoirs as the lambs trade fell hard to an SQQ of 260p/kg. Simple facts being that, half of the buyers in attendance could not even muster a bid for Lambs as Export and home trade orders fell silent. Difficult trade throughout but the large number of underweight and underfinished Lambs on display certainly not aiding the days trading. Top today 331p/kg at 36kg from E Brain & Sons Ltd with D & BJ Leadbeater 38kg at 329p/kg and Dabba Mitchell 325p/kg. In the heavies a slow also as Smithfield closed play for the day seeing a top of 306p/kg at 48kg from Bailey & Moore, Lutterworth and 299p/kg at 48.5kg from Messrs Claridge. 296p/kg at 49kg from Messrs Taylor & Son and 292p/kg at 48kg from G R Fountaine & Son, Milton Keynes with J & S White Farms Ltd, 50kg to 280p/kg. ## THURSDAY 17TH JUNE STORE CATTLE SALE



Into the depths of June and Cattle drying up. But Slaughter returns remain high and as a result Buyers old and new lining the ringside throughout. Trade simply on fire and seemingly £120 up on comparable for the week. We started with some expertly reared Calves from Messrs Peebles, seeing a top of £805 at 8 months. Others 6 months at £700 & £705 whilst Blues to £670 to £650. Next in and trade flying high when a super 14 month old Steer saw Blue Steers from Stimson Farming & Co, Milton Keynes taking the headlines at £1325!!! On into a marvellous consignment of Limousin from D Tallis, Higham on the Hill. These overnight Cattle met a huge audience of Buyers selling to a top of £1470 for 18 month old Limousin Steers with others £1385 and £1270 whilst Heifers saw £1200. The younger proportion of the Consignments saw Steers to £1170 at 14 months others 13-15 months saw £1105, £1100, £1070 and £1060. Sisters to the same saw £1100 at 15 months and a super 14 month to £1140. A return today from Hull Farms, Essex with TB4 11 to 14 month old Cattle. The Consignment just short of 60 Avg £1038. Topping at £1200 for a pair of Charolais Steers 14 months others followed at £1110 and big pens at £1090. Simmentals to £1090 and shaped Charolais £1095 at only 12 months of age!! Stockier shaped Charolais saw £1140 at 13 months. Salers topped at £1130 and £1125 with many running well over £1050. Only the smaller types following the Mothers lines dipping under £1000. Next in loyal supporters Steve and Steph Powell showed yearling Angus Bucket Steers to £800, Montbeliardes £700 and Hereford Heifers to £700. John Hill, Lutterworth in the ring for the third sale on the trot to top at £1000 for Limousin Heifers 21 months before J Gwilym Williams, Lutterworth followed in with outlying Herefords to see Yearlings at £1040 and 24 month olds to £1160. Duncan Dawes holding the Dairy farmers end up to see Blue Heifers out of Jersey to £1060 at 21 months of age. Trade simply put flying but on the whole a yard of genuine Cattle that had never previously been in a shed. We look forward to another good yarding for the July Sale.
