PRIME CATTLE: 58 HEAD

A good entry number-wise, which mainly consisted of dairy bred cattle was offered to a full company of buyers, with several men present, who's regular markets were closed. All buyers wanted cattle regardless of breed, sex, weight and stood there corner to get them. Trade taking quality into account would be 3-5p dearer on the week.

STEERS:14 HEAD

An excellent entry for meat but several been dairy bred lacked conformation but no matter, buyers for everything, trade on fire and numbers woefully short of buyers needs. Messrs Baylis topped the section at 206p for heavyweight's. Messrs Trice opened their account for the season selling home-bred dairy steers also to 206p for a Blue, other steers sold to 205p for a Limousin from Town Farm. Heavyweight's sold to £1411.20 from Messrs Trice for a Blue.

HEIFERS:19 HEAD

As ever the bulk of the entry, buyers in all corners of the ring wanting them and an excellent trade ensued. Taking top price in the section and sale was a superb Blue Heifer from Simon Darker which realised 215p followed at 203p from Messrs Burton. The trade of the day was for the commercial heifers which would easily be 5p dearer on the week, with plenty of native breeds 185-195p. Top price per head was £1294.30 from Simon Darker, with others to £1176.09 from Messrs Trice for dairy bred Blues.

Overage and OTM's:7 HEAD

2 extra buyers at ringside, trade on fire. Rob Evans topped the sale with a young Simmental cow at 153p followed by sisters at 129p. Others sold to 121p for red and white's from Messrs Barber, with others 116p from Tommy Williams, the overall average being 121.5p Top price per head was £1022.04 from Messrs Evans, Wroxall. As demand at ringside grows for OTM's with 6 active bidders operating more cattle are needed to supply demand.

Prime Hoggs: 1636 Forward SQQ 238p/kg

A number reduced by the fact it was a Bank Holiday but still a yarding of 1700 with plenty travelling from away today. A blistering trade for a poor yarding of quality with Hoggs 52kg and under on fire. Whilst those heavier worth less and less for each extra kilo they weigh past 52kg. An SQQ of 238p/kg with Euro spec Hoggs simply flying topping at 293p/kg for Beltex at 37.5kg from Laban Partners, Lutterworth ahead of 277p/kg from BJ & IS Wain at 277p/kg for 45.5kg. Messrs Laban also 273p/kg at 45kg and N Sheppard, Stratford Upon Avon 39kg to 272p/kg . In the heavies Hopcraft Bros top at 236p/kg for 46kg with R J Osborn & Son 46kg at 236p/kg and Laban Partners, 55kg to 235p/kg. In the lump Euro Hoggs really starting to add up selling to £126 for 45.5kg from BJ & IS Wain with Messrs Laban Partners taking £123 and others at the same weight 45kg £116. Overall Laban Partners reign Supreme selling to £129 for 55kg with J Wallington £117.50 at 50.5kg with 50kg to £116. Hoggs today likely a flash in the pan trade responding to shortage of numbers but export Hoggs likely to stay strong with finish well rewarded. Heavy Hoggs well over supplied and at the current time a very hard sell.


