CATTLE: 56

An entry just short of 60 head was on offer to a full company of buyers which saw 10 men purchase cattle. Trade was again firmer on the week with the working cattle looking the best sold, cows again on fire and everything in demand.

STEERS: Increased numbers on the week met good demand from all corners of the ring-side with averages well up on the week taking quality into consideration. A tremendous muscled Limousin from Peter Calcott topped the section at 237p. Heavyweight's sold to 231p for a 721 kilo red Limousin from Ces and Malcolm Thomas which realised £1665.51. Native breeds met a strong enquiry from buyers, topping at 180p for holstein's from Geoff Walker.

HEIFERS: Quality throughout the entry with demand outstripping supply, Nick Foster superb black topped the section and sale at 237p, others sold to 230p for heavyweight Blues from Ces and Malcolm Thomas, which topped the section at £1465.00.

COWS: TRADE SIMPLY ON FIRE.

An entry just short of 30 head, met a white-hot demand from ringside, it did not matter if they were beef or dairy bred, FABBL or NON FABBL, well finished or in working clothes everything was wanted. Heart of England topped the section and sale at 160p with a black cow, grossing £1238.61, other beef cows sold to 159p for Simmentals from Rob Evans who's load averaged £1163.55. Dairy cows sold extremely well with a massive Friesian from the Barnett Boys weighing 885 kilo's selling at 139p and realising £1230.15, others sold to 157p from Messrs Dalby, realising £998.52. Cows in their working clothes sold to 136p from David Gilbert, more are urgently needed to supply growing demand. Over-age cattle sold to 181p from Meadowsweet Farm and to £1168.64 from Manor Farm.

SPRING LAMBS: 1119 Forward SQQ 217p/kg

The Day when it all started to tumble with limited demand from a holidaying Continent and a home trade basking in the sunshine and clearly not eating spring lamb the averages fell all around with only a lack of Supply in the North showing a different picture. A orchestrated fall in numbers to aid trade. Today we thank our buyers strength and loyalty in returning an SQQ of 217p/kg which represented a 10p/kg lift over trade in near proximity on the day. Light lambs simply unwanted unless well-bred. Heavy meat a wanted commodity despite the downturn. In the Euro spec a top for smart 38kg from AEJ & FJ Claridge at 237p/kg equal with Beltex 30kg from Lucas Betteridge. IM Allen & Partners sold 36kg Beltex to 236 and Messrs Claridge 42kg 233p/kg. In the heavies a top of 223p/kg for 52kg from FJ Tombs & Son and S & J Farming 215p/kg for 47kg. In the lump Euro lambs to £100.50 for 44kg from Messrs Claridge, £99.50 for 45kg from the same and £98.50 for 45kg from Angela Russell. Overall a top of £116 twice from Messrs Tombs with MM Clarke & Sons £103 for 48kg. A hard day and interestingly not a desire from the buyers to drop the trade but merely an admission they are struggling to sell the product at all.
