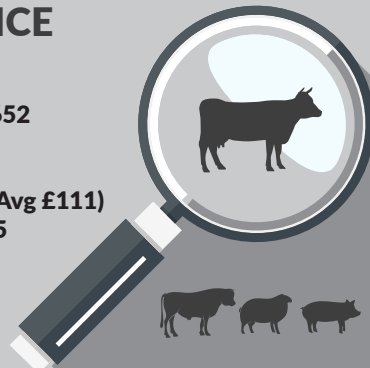

A buyer short today at the very last minute but thankfully not effecting the trade. A nice number forward but a lot of untested Store cattle on show. Meat well rewarded and wanted throughout.

Thick meat the order of the day to see 270p/kg for medium weight Limousin Steers from RW & HER Trivett, Atherstone whilst heavyweight Limousin U- from N W Turner. Solihull saw 263.5p/kg ahead of Messrs Fountaine. Top gross though going with weight to see £1792 for Nathan Turner. R Grades generally 245 to 255p/kg subject to feeding O + to 232p/kg.

Heifers;

Meat and shape at the top end to see a super stylish heifer boxed fed from Pete Jarrom climb to 290p/kg for U+ whilst weighted heifers from RW & HER Trivett saw 269p/kg with N W Turner 260p/kg. R Grades to 255p/kg and best fed O+ into the 240's. Top gross £1652 from the Trivett Family with Pete Jarrom £1580 and PC & RA Nichols £1575. Stock Bulls saw Limousin to £1365 from P C Cox, Lutterworth.

In truth a yarding that continues see lambs struggling for final finish as the weather conditions continue to hamper farmers. Trade though on fire seeing an SQQ of 253p/kg which on last weeks kill returns 548p/kg dw. Best end lambs wanted but not quite at the premium of previous years with Export trade not functioning as we have previously seen. Trade though massively favourable to farmers and an all in Avg of £111 this week very favourable with less weight on display than we have been seeing. Top today smart small lambs at 33kg for the City trade from Di Hopcraft taking 315p/kg. Beltex 37kg from M J Woodward to 297p/kg with BJ & IS Wain 39.5kg to 292p/kg and 40kg to 290p/kg. Heavies chased if meat and look a very dear commodity topping at 276p/kg for 46kg from B C Burton with BJ & IS Wain 46kg to 273p/kg and G R Fountaine & Son 48kg to 271p/kg. 46kg from Ben Burton and Humphrey Livestock saw 268 and 264p/kg. Export weights all well competed for today with standard Export weights coming back into vogue with 38 to 40kg Export weights very dear throughout albeit having to be, to stay ahead of the current Store trade here at RFM. Top Export weights saw 45kg to £123.50 from B C Burton with equal weights at £123 and BJ & IS Wain 45.5kg to £123 whilst 44kg from Messrs Wain to £121 and 45kg £121 from F Hodgkin. Heavies wanted throughout and pen after pen over £130 topping at £148.50 for 68kg from L Krypczyk, Bucks with B T Caswel & Son, Northampton to £144 at 60kg and AJ Breakspear 67kg to £143.50 and T Wood £141.50. E J Taylor 59kg Suffolks to £141 with Messrs Goode, Hodgkin, MFH Farming, Batchelor and Wootton all over £140.

Trade remains strong. Lambs continue to percent badly this year as they seem to find the natural climate not in their favour. On this basis the continued trade is even more remarkable. We encourage vendors to please now feed lambs with the rewards very much evident for all parties.

A nice yarding with many extra entries on the day met a ring full of buyers throughout to produce a strong trade from start to finish. The first lot a young Blue x Cow with 3 month Calf at foot from New Pastures Care Farm set the tone when flying to £1720.

Baby Bulls wanted in the current meat trading climate and on this basis A N Calcott selling 9 month Blue Bulls to £940. Up from Reading, Red Kite Farms started their run with Angus Bulls to £1210. On into the Stores and young cattle which traded ahead of logic with the weather and time of year often steadying mid range cattle at this time of the year. None of it though, and we started off well at £580 for Longhorn Steers 7 months old from T Henderson, Northampton. New Pastures Care Farm then sold 9 month old Angus to £910 for Steers and Heifers to £840 for Blues at 8 months. D & GM Wright run of 11 to 12 month cattle looked a smart shot with Simmentals to £950 for Steers. Good style Angus out of Simmentals for JS & N Morley saw 11 -12 month Steers at £1070 and £970 for large pens with others £905. Sisters of this run then topping at £880 for 11 months. A real run this week from the Semple Family saw a marvellous run top out at £1355 for Limousin Steers 11 months of age. The same selling pairs of Steers at £1260, £1190 and £1180. Sisters took £1190 and big pens at £1150. J & S White Farms Ltd came across from the Welland Valley to see a marvellous run of well grown South Devons top pen of 5 take £1210 at 12 to 16 months with Angus £1130 at 16 months and Blues off the Bucket £990. A trio of Sisters to £1130 and others £1030. Strength from the Friswell family acted as an amuse bouche to their annual Suckled Calf consignment. Topping at £1500 the families others Steers taking £1450 at 20 months. Sisters saw £1340. A real run of Shorthorns from the Hague family who's investment in the breed now shines through. Topping at £1305 for a 19 month old others to £1295 for a trio the 19-20 month old Steers were followed by £1195, £1100 and £1090. S & J Farming always have a large following and no different this year with a top for a trio of Charolais Heifers 18 - 20 months £1340 for Heifers. Another South Devon from H H Wadland & Sons saw Steers to £1195 at 19 months. A nice run of outside ran cattle from A N Calcott saw demand throughout to £1250 top for Charolais Steers at 18 months, £1250 for Limousin Heifers 20 months and £1250 Charolais Heifers 24 months. T H Lee sold there good Montbeliarde x today to top at £1130 for Simmentals 22months with Pure Montbeliardes £1150 and £1105 with others £1000. Red Kite Farms, Reading then back int the ring to see Angus Steers top out at £1280 for a pair with large pens £1200 and £1145 at 22 to 23 months. Messrs Fenemore up from Buckingham saw warm Shorthorn Steers at £1395 for 30 months of age. Those a year younger saw £1060 and £1050 for 5. Last man for the day saw J Arthers sell late entries to £1240 and £1235 for Limousin Steers 17 months and older 25 months at £1235. Sisters saw £1170 at 23 months with Blues 16 months to £1160.
