A tailored entry of only 1476 with the Bank Holiday spitting up an anomaly of various buyers closing down Abbatoirs for a 4 day weekend. Our job here is to market lambs for vendors and not just collect commission and for this reason producers today encouraged only to sell those lambs spoiling. Trade has to be reported as strong at 186p/kg SQQ equivalent to a £4kg deadweight with numbers just proving to be 100 more than the demand we had on the day. We are here to Market not just sell!!

In the lambs best sorts supported by a returning Continental buyer seeing a top of 217p/kg for Beltex from Hillside Farm ahead of H Collins & Son at 215p/kg at 40kg proving that this weeks NSA judge knows what he is looking for. John Elkington saw 211p/kg at 37.5kg and Sam Treadgold 211p/kg from Pillerton Priors just beating Garth Shelby Doyle at 210p/kg for 40kg. In the heavies meat rewarded but 44kg to 49kg an unsupported weight range indicating slow home trade. Top today 193p/kg at 46kg from Ben Nichols with prodigy Edmund Ringer 51kg at 186p/kg and Ben 49kg at equal money. In the lump lambs with meat and finish totting up but those underdone hard to sell. H Collins & Son £86 for 40kg whilst Hillside Farm 45kg to £85.50 and J Dronfield 44kg to £85. Heavies harder to shift this week but making to £95 for 51kg from Edmund Ringer with MM Clarke & Sons 50 and 53kg £94 and £93 whilst Culworth Grounds £91.50 at 49.5kg and J Webster £91 at 50.5kg equal with PC & RA Nichols.

Trade seemingly dealing with a strengthening of the pound and awaiting the end of the Summer Holidays.

! CHAIRMANS UPDATE !

Please see below a letter received from the Estates Manager, Colin Hooper, in regards to the proposed relocation of the Market.

There is obviously a lot of work going on behind the scenes, but the below acts as an update on the current hurdles dictating as to the validity of the project.

Dear Tom,

Thanks for your email enquiring about progress on the relocation of the RFM and for coming to the office to discuss the project.

As I explained, planning permission has been approved for the new building and last autumn the construction contract was successfully tendered thus confirming the cost of the project. All this information has been supplied to HS2 so it can assess the detail. Since submitting the information, HS2 has been undertaking its own surveys and cost analysis to confirm the results we supplied. This work was completed very recently and the HS2 property team have prepared a paper which is now due to go to HS2 Governance Committee for final sign off. I have been told that the Committee are expected to respond by the end of October.

Assuming the project to approved by HS2 it will be at that point we will need to finalise details with RFM.
