Trade continues to hold with a Stand on Sqq of 226p/kg despite a definite drop in quality this week. 39kg upwards in demand but noticeably today those under this weight the hardest to sell. In the Euro section a top of 248p/kg from James Grindal at 40kg. Wendy Taylor saw 39kg to 244p/kg and T E Payne & Son 241p/kg for 39kg. Today 533 lambs trading over 230p/kg.. In the heavies a top p/kg of 237p/kg for 48.5kg from Messrs Seckington. M W Warner sold to 228p/kg at 46kg for Suffolks and WH & IM Butcher 50kg at the same money. In the lump a top of £104.50 for 45kg from MM Clarke & Sons ahead of Messrs Seckington £104 for 45kg and Alan Boffey £103.50 for 45kg. Overall a top of £119 from Oakland College, Hertfordshire at 55kg. Showell Farms, Nuneaton saw £116 at 56kg. Today 535 lambs selling over £100. Trade again buoyant and buyers out in numbers today with a full team and fresh accounts. The time of year now though when producers must reevaluate what they send to kill. Lambs now starting to weigh from frame not meat. Please draw to finish not just target weights.

Again a good number with the best part of 800 through. Trade less as predicted as Ramadan celebrations come to an end and normal life resumes. That said not anywhere as much as expected. Heavy ewes £8 less on the week and poor breaking Ewes perhaps £10. Meat and finish well rewarded today selling to £121 for S Pearman, Worcester with Rams. A Spencer, Lower Quinton topped the females for a pen of 9 Texels at £118. Suffolks today topping at £110 for WSE & CA Moreby with a pen of 21 from MJ Harris Farming selling to £110. T E Payne & Son saw Texles to £106. Mules still dear selling to £96 from A J Breakspear with others at £90.

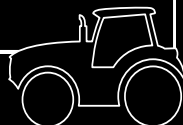
