Woefully short of Lambs today as vendors found they had drawn what meat they had or some that worried for the trade following dismal figures posted for Thursday Markets in the Midlands. They should not of worried, trade simply blistering today with end user buyers keen for numbers to an SQQ of 223p/kg. Lamb quality poor today with a yarding predominantly of Suffolks or weighted crossbreds but the void for best end lambs evident in last weeks sale fully filled this week with Customers for Belgium and Holland fit for lambs as Januarys Pay day hits banks on the Continent. Best fed lambs chased throughout and rewarded handsomely. Top today in the Export weight bracket of 278p/ kg for Beltex from Doody Livestock Haulage with a pen of 45kg meat. A penny behind was Martin and Caroline Doody, Tom Hill with 37.5kg ahead of Martin Woodward with 40kg at 268p/kg. First in the draw today D W Gurney & Son 41kg to 263p/kg. Best end lambs very short of requirements today. In the heavies a top ppk of 237p/kg at 47kg from SM & CR Collinswood Transport, Thame ahead of Keith Crabtree, Great Horwood showing 46kg at 228p/kg and our regular supplier of quality finished weighted Lambs Humphrey Livestock 49kg at 224p/ kg. In the lump handyweight lambs top of all the trees today with Dave Doody taking £125 for 45kg with his Father taking equal weight to £117 whilst K Crabtree saw 44.5kg to £109 Messrs Guerney 41kg at £108. Overall heavies a trade that lifted in this centre against the National trend due only to a shortage of weight in the lines here. 56kg from R & M Arrowsmith saw £114, 61kg from R Mounsey saw £116. 57kg from Humphrey Livestock saw £118 whilst 71kg from WSE & CA Moreby saw £120 equal with 66kg from Brian and Dan Aries, Banbury.
