Lambs; All in avg £107

A shortage of numbers with more expected but the biblical downpours at 6am to 8am leaving a few happy to let the lambs have another chance! Again we had the best of the trade seeing an Sqq of 235p/kg representing a swift move forward and a deadweight comparison well over £5.15. Trade sluggish with the Auctioneer needing to convince buyers to take a gamble of a rejuvenated demand during the week but again a policy of dealing with decision makers paying off for those selling lambs today. Best end Export lambs wanted and taken to 284 and 283p/kg for 37kg from R Richins, Oxford. Hillside Farm drew on Sunday morning to see 41kg to 259p/kg and a super run of 120 from B C Burton saw 42.5kg to 259p/kg equal with R Heckford. Quality again short on supply and best end fed lambs working at a premium to see 47kg to 277p/kg from B Burton with 49kg from Richins showing Beltex get weight and shape. B Burton and R Heckford then 46kg to 261 and 262p/kg. Todays all in avg of £107 paying farmers for efforts and an indicator of how well the lamb trade remains. In the lump Export lambs topping at £114 for 45kg from B Burton who also sold at £113 and J B Elkington 45kg to £112.50 with HN & SE Staines 45kg to £112. Weight well chased today and selling to a top of £143.50 at 59kg from Humphrey Livestock Ltd selling to B Wilson, Essex. H L Goode & Son sold proper meat to 61.5kg at £142 and R Haynes 59kg to £139.50 with 120 today trading over £125. Sales still very slow but hopefully the change in weather will return a greater demand in coming weeks.

Age Ewes traded very well for quality seeing Texels to £120 from Rob Milner whilst Scotch Mules to £119 from G Hawkins & Sons. Super NCM full mouth saw a top of £138 x2 pens and £134 from DW Gurney & Son.. Double Theaves saw NCM from Mythe Farm sell to £133 and Beltex from Stuart Taylor £175. Into the Theaves with a blistering start of £200 for a pen of Blue Texel Theaves from L C Threadgold & Son. Suffolks took £155 from John Goodman for 22 up from Thame.
