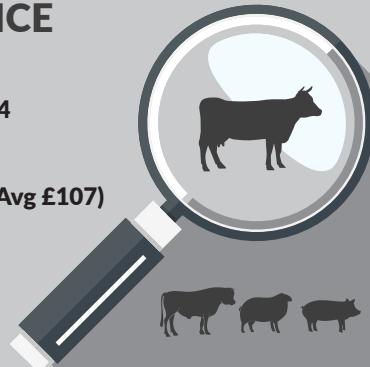

A yarding short on numbers and quality. Over half of the cattle today unable to meet the 220kg minimum deadweight limit. That said those showing meat and finish very well rewarded.

Some properly fed Cattle from Pete Jarrom today topping out at 253.5 and 252.5p/kg with U Grade Limousin Steers with R Grade well fed Herefords from White Bros taking 229p/kg and 228p/kg. J P Seymour weighted R Grades to 227p/kg. The lump totting to £1571 at 14 months of age with others £1540.

Heifers;

Very much the same story with Messrs Jarrom 256.6p/kg for a U Grade with U- 251p/kg and a Blue from Whites of Grendon 235p/kg. R Grades to 228p/kg and down to 220p/kg. Top gross £1354 from Pete Jarrom bought by Hartshead Meats, Manchester.

A steadier number as the morning torrential rains slowed a few as did the recent slow in trade and further fall as the week drew on. That said today's SQQ of 255p/kg a massive improvement on the week and a return miles ahead of deadweight comparison. More of a spark in the job this week and trade for quality for all to see. Top today seeing the 300p/kg mark broken for a 43kg Texel at 302p/kg with H Collins & Son, Northampton 298p/kg and with Miss A Wain showing the families stockmans eye when selling shape to 288p/kg at 41kg. Heavies a continued favourable trade and H Collins & Son topping at 290p/kg at 48kg with Upton Mill Farm Ltd, 49kg to 280p/kg. 46kg from H Colloins & Son 277p/kg and 51kg Texel from AJ & E Hall, Atherstone 275p/kg. In the lump Export weights topping up well and many over three figures. Top Export weights to 43kg from AJ & E Hall at £130. BF Humphrey & Son 43.5kg £122.50 and 44kg to £123. Overall a top today from AJ & E Hall at 51kg to £140 with S Brodie 61kg to £140 and H Collins & Son 48kg to £139. £137 49kg from Upton Mill Farms and the famous MFH Farming 49kg to £134.50. A tumble in trade from what we have become used to. Today though a real triumph with returns massively past any Deadweight quote and well ahead of Abbatoir predictions as of Friday. The significance of this positive move, albeit small, seems to act as an indicator that last months huge trade hasn't completely removed lambs from the 'menu' of Wholesalers as some had feared. Thanks to all vendors who made the effort in awful conditions yesterday morning.
