Prime Hoggs: 2291 Forward SQQ 240p/kg

Simply on fire.. To really understand the trade the yarding of sheep also needed inspection with many clear up lots returning an SQQ of 240p/kg across the 2291 lambs in the aisles today. Best end lambs in real demand but in truth, quality not available here in any numbers today. Instead some well finished lambs on show and also clean presented belly trimmed sorts hotly contested for. Dead weight bids today would need to be in excess of £5.10p/kg to even standstill

In the Export weight lambs a top of 313p/kg for Garth Doyle with 39kg Beltex and 295p/kg for his 38kg bellied and overnight lambs. Jack Lombard, Banbury showed 43.5kg to 290p/ kg and equal bred 37kg at 285p/kg ahead of Woody Pecker with 39kg at £110. Norfolk traveller saw Mr Gardiners run of 139 Hoggs top at 280p/kg at 43.5kg purchased by Pak Mecca Meats Ltd. Today 165 lambs traded over 250p/kg. In the heavies plenty of trade and a top of 241p/kg at 46kg from Mr G Tew, Crick with Fernhill Farm Ltd 47kg to 240p/ kg and SLAM Farming 46kg at 239p/kg. Trade for finish consistent throughout and all well rewarded. In the lump a top of £126 for a full pen at 43.5kg from Jack Lombard whilst Garth Doyle saw £122 at 39kg and Messrs Gardiner £122 at 43.5kg. PE & EH King Brackley showed overnight clipped lambs to £116 at 45kg. Overall dominated by the Cook Family whom sent up 139 from Bristol on Sunday night for clipping and took a total avg across the load of £122.24. The run Topped at £139.50 for 69kg with 74kg to £138 and 65kg to £135 whilst 59kg saw two full pens in a row at £131. Trade today simply flying. Why? Maybe Brexit worries for Export futures, Maybe Supermarkets having to come to Markets to replace shortfalls in International Imports. Or perhaps its because in British lamb, we have a quality of product that the whole Continent and further beyond have a demand for?. In any case a blistering trade and enough to bring those weighing and preying to tears.

SUNDAY; The Market and its Staff provide a clipping and penning Service on Sunday to help vendors and to Limit Ques on Mondays. The pens are bedded for delivery from first thing Sunday morning. We then hold a cut off for deliveries after 4pm. Based on this cut off the Staff do not get to leave before 9pm on average and some weeks they leave after midnight. Please note that to allow the Staff some time in their beds before Monday opening at 5.30am this deadline will be strictly enforced.


