## **CATTLE: 37**

### **PRIME CATTLE**

A cattle entry severely effected by several vendors among grass or shearing saw the usual large company of buyers at ringside with several old faces making a welcome reappearance. Trade was tremendous in the Bulls and the Prime Cattle with the OTM,s just barely maintaining the flying trade experienced the past fortnight.

**BULLS:** An entry consisting solely of native breeds, saw Black and Whites sell to 184p, and Traditional Angus selling to 180p both sold by Geoff Walker.

**STEERS:** An extremely mixed entry for breed, quality and weight saw buyer strength at ringside push the trade 3p dearer on the week. Top price was 222p for a heavyweight Blonde from JA & S Wrench, Native breeds all dairy bred sold to 177p from the Barnett Bros. Top price per head was £1629.60 paid for a 776 kilo Simmental Steer which sold for 210p from Mr N.J. Foster, Fulready, with others selling to £1629.54(198p) for 823 kg from the same stable .

**HEIFERS:** A much improved entry for numbers, weight and quality met a ready demand from the 9 butchers and wholesalers at ringside. Messrs Tivey topped the sale at 235p with a smart Limousin grass heifer, others to 232p from Parry Walters. Top price per head was £1265.88 from Parry.

**OTM,s:** Short entry due to the above, met an excellent trade, but barely the trade of previous weeks. Cows sold to 150p from Mr.J.R. Morris and the section averaged 124.5p. A Cast Bull from Mr. Morris created large interest at ringside weighing 1192kilos and grossing £1656.88. As ever more are needed to supply demand. Euro Spec lambs selling to J & R Lowe at £120 for 45kg with 44kg £117 and S & J Farming equal. ## 26th May M R Beaty & Sons Farm Sale

A marvellous days weather and the most genuine of Farm Dispersals for Messrs M R Beaty & Sons, Rock Farm, saw a huge crowd of onlookers with buyers in attendance from Burnley in Lancashire to Devon and most counties in-between.

RFM, best known for its livestock sales put a ring of buyers together for the Livestock and a field full for the Machinery. In the Cows a Herd avg across all Cow and Calf units on show. Topping the trade a 2011 Simmental Cow carrying twin Angus calves 2 months old sold for £1990. Next a shapely but aged 2008 Blue Cow and Angus baby Angus calf sold to £1850. Simmental units 2011 sold to £1810 with 3 month Angus calf. Age seemingly not an issue to buyers with 2008 and 2003 Cows regularly making £1500 to £1670 with 2/3 month old Angus calves at foot. 2003 incalf Cows sold £1270 as if to prove the point. The best advert for the Pedigree Aberdeen Angus bull, were the bonny calves at foot. Being four years old the Bull went on to sell for £2250.

Highlights of the day include the sale of the 12ft twin axle Ifor Williams £3250 at 5 years old, Kubota RTV 1390Hrs for £6500. The 2006 JCB 520 with 4000 Hours sold to a private farmer at £18100 with the older Case a W Reg CX100 sold to a Herefordshire buyer at £14400 and the Case 105 with MX loader on a 61plate sold to £22400.

Included items;

A welcome addition to the sale was the inclusion of nearly 200 extra put in lots of Machinery. The highlight of this section being a 2013 trailed Sheep dip unit sold by Hull Farms, Essex. The item found interest from buyers all over Wales, the Midlands, and the South West of England. The lot ended up being fought over by phone bidders eventually being sold to a large flock in Bridport, Dorset for £7700. A Welgar conventional Baler, not used for many years sold to £1720. Bunning dump trailers to £3750 and a aged Bobcat loader for Spares or repairs returned £5050.

Even though it is early, the Texel rams saw a high of £365 for Full Mouth rams, selling to Derbyshire.

Fodder sold to a strong crowd, with silage to £14 per bale, and wheat straw to £35 per quadrant bale.

Into the small items which saw Lister Shearing Machines to £180, Rolls of Bale Wrap to £100, Chainsaws to £95, Two Milk Churns to £95, Bales Spikes to £92, Chains to £78, Compressors to £65 and Wooden Chests to £55.

Moving out into the field saw Bags of Wood to £55, Culvert pipes to £165, Antique Potato Spinner reached £95, Cast Coppers to £290. Moving into the livestock equipment which saw sheep hurdles to £65 for 4, with sheep ring feeders to £62. Sheep foot baths reached £655, with races to £270. Calf Creeps to £650, with cattle crushes to £1050.
