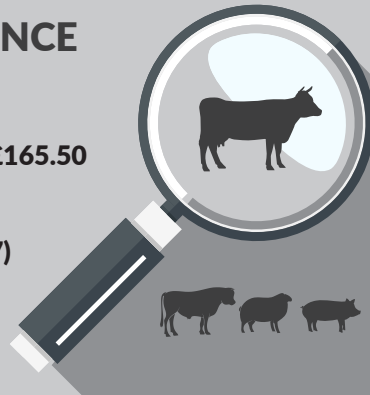

That said a flyer of a trade at 310p/kg SQQ. Top man today Bailey & Moore, Lutterworth with 35kg Beltex to 350p/kg ahead of Cotswold vendor Wychwood Organics with 39.5kg to 347p/kg. C Page, Banbury saw 40.5kg to 337p/kg and 39.5kg to 330p/kg. In the weight a very good following seeing 47kg from Hull Farms, Essex take 319p/kg equal with DG Coombes and 46kg from Boulton Bros 46kg to 317p/kg whilst Heathrow based H Levinge saw 50kg to 316p/kg. A J Breakspear to 314p/kg. In the lump Hogs tallying up on Export weights to £142.50 for V Phipps, Banbury and equal money for Dadbrook Farms, Thame both at 45.5kg. P Edwards, Stratford Upon Avon saw £140.50 at 43kg and R A Deeley £140.50 for 44.5kg. Overall heavies really tallying up and with our limited Commission band vendors really reaping rewards today. THURSDAY 1ST APRIL STORE CATTLE SALE



Trade rumbles on at speed and buyers out in force to receive the high quality of cattle on show at Stoneleigh.

We as ever started with the Cows seeing a 2017 Hereford Cow with 3 month calf at foot from Len Mathews take £1420.

Onto the Feeding Bulls and Pedigree producers AJ Bostock walked away well compensated selling Charolais Bulls to £940 at 10 months with others £810 and £805. A F Thompson showed weighted Storey Bulls to £1080 at 15 months.

Young Cattle retain a massive audience and first man in the ring S Daly saw Blue Heifers leave at £1200 for only 8 months proving best quality and sure Bets are the key to trade. 11 month Old Blondes from Roger Wixey saw £1005 and £1000 with others £990 whilst sisters to £830. A super draw from R A Stephens this year, a pleasure to sell, saw a wonderful avg of £1014 for the 29 forward seeing strength and genuine shape for the 12-13 months Limousins top at £1180 and then see seven Steers sold to three new homes at £1050 and a single Angus Steer £1010. Sister the real show of the run with the top six making £1060 others £1020, £1000 and £985. Quality just kept coming today with out annual Spring consignment from A North & Son, Lower Quinton showing a run that buyers travel for. This super run of genuine Cattle topped at £1300 for only 13 months of age Limousin x Blue Steers with others all born in February selling to £1260, £1225 x3, £1245 x3, £1215 £1150 and £1135. Sisters to £1095 and £1070. A credit to Messrs North and their efforts. Up the ages and A Neary, Solihull sold to £1060 at 19 months for Blue Steers whilst selling 14 month Angus to £930. Another super run from Leicestershires OJ & JM Guest who managed to top the day with 21 month old Simmental Steers to £1510!! And as though to prove it not a fluke his next genuine Store saw £1400. Blue Steers to £1160 and Charolais £1145 for 17 -18 month Steers. A Single 14 month quality Limousin Steer to £1020. Heifers just the same quality to see £1210 x3 at 19 months with younger 15 months to £1065.

Aged Stores from Messrs Barnett, Fillongley made a mockery of previous valuations when topping at £1360 for Blue Steers 21 months of age with a pair of Angus brothers £1345 19 months other pens full of Angus £1200 and £1150 with Herefords £1280 for big pens full and Blues matching the mark at £1280 and £1200. A wonderful Blue from a true British Friesian saw the Heifers kick off well at £1300 with Blondes £1015. To prove the young artist Barnetts supremacy he then went on to sell Holsteins to £1005. Another annual caller K Welsby showed the most genuine frame and haired cattle to sell Simmentals 17 months to £1230 and £1190, £1160 and others £1130. Sisters regularly over £1055. K Finch travelled across to see South Devon Heifers to £1160 for a pair at 25 months of age. We go again with the Show and Sale on the 15th where we expect a yarding over 500.
