PRIME CATTLE:55 HEAD

First cattle sale of the New Year at Stoneleigh, saw an excellent entry of over 60 head penned. Quality was extremely varied, but that said, the vast majority were well finished. The 10 buyers at ringside were old and new faces with several making a welcome reappearance looking to replenish stocks after a successful Christmas trade. As ever butcher types were wanted everywhere at ringside, but the commercial cattle like other outlets were a similar trade.

STEERS:18 STEERS

An entry of commercial heavyweight types, saw all types wanted at ringside with several new buyers operating. Ces Thomas topped the section with a 712 kilo continental at 212p, others sold to 210p from Wolston. Heavyweights were dominated by Ces, selling to £1495.20 and £1441.60 per head. Herefords from Pete Yeomans realised £1292.20, with home-breds from Messrs Cross to £1268.75.

HEIFERS: 37 HEIFERS

Super entry of butcher types, with several good runs forward. Topping the section and sale was a Red Limousin from Richard Grindal at 216p per kilo, who sold others to 215p. Another load of heifers from Kent sold to 209p twice from Messrs Ferguson. Commercial types were good to sell, however anything too ripe was discounted. Heavyweight cattle sold to £1379.04 for a Charolais from Ces Thomas, with others £1326.10 Messrs Caswell.

The first day of the Hoggetts saw a bumper trade for all categories with new buyers at ringside for the yarding of just over 2500. Hogs today from Essex to the South and Shropshire and Staffordshire to the North. An Sqq of 212p/kg a remarkable return although how sustainable the trade is remains to be seen and we must monitor this day to day as the pressures of January Finances ware on. In the Euro weight lambs today a top ppk of a massive 281p/kg at 38.5kg from GJ & SL Gowling with 41kg from the same 268p/kg both for Beltex. Laban Partners 35kg to 261p/kg and equal weight Beltex from C B E Price 246p/kg. In the heavies a top of 49kg at 227p/kg from C B E Price with properly bred sorts and K Crabtree, Winslow 46kg to 226p/kg. In the lump light weight lambs really adding up today to take a top in the section of £110 for 41kg and £108 for 38.5kg from Stuart Gowling. Weekly supporter B C Burton 43.5kg and 44kg at £100.50. Overall today heavies on fire buyers seemingly this week all needing the weight. A top today of £133.50 for 73kg from Ted Taylor and Messrs Tombs, Thame £133 for 64kg. First in the draw H L Goode & Son 65kg to £126 and BMF Smith £121 for 62kg. Today 502 Hogs grossing over the £100 mark.
