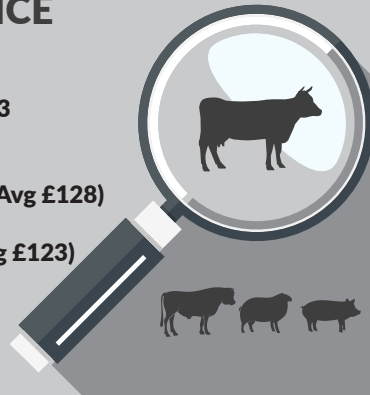

CATTLE: 74 FORWARD



A very nice yarding with the best show of genuine meat we have seen. Not all top graders but the extra feeding well rewarded.

Steers; The long distance overnight Cattle from LAV Farms and also K Butcher well received with the well bred Limousin Steers selling to 254p/kg for a good U grade heavy steer whilst other U- grades 251 and 248p/kg closely followed by N J Foster at 241p/kg. R Grades to 230p/kg for best fed sorts with the majority 220p/kg plus. O+ grade regularly trading over 210p/kg where meated.

In the lump a top today of £1748 for K Butcher selling meated Limousin Steers to Ralph Pearson Wholesale Butchers, Bradford. Well fed meat from G R Fontaine to £1611 and K Butcher £1547 and £1508.

Heifers; Shown up by the boys today for quality albeit only because of the excellent quality of Steers on show. Price wise though a different league of trade for the quality with buyers seemingly returning from a strong weekend of Sales. Top today for properly fed U- from PC & RA Nichols selling 616kg to 244p/kg equal with 600kg from GR Fontaine & Son. Blue x from NJ Foster saw Shop Heifers to 243p/kg whilst heavy weight Heifers from J & R Lowe, Rugby a welcome return to this ring at 240p/kg and 668kg. R Grades up to 235p/kg and O+ Grades at 225p/kg looking a real trade. In the Gross J & R Lowe at £1604 with Messrs Nichols £1504, Caswell, Stephens x2 and G R Fontaine & Son all well over £1400.

Bulls; The Buyers want Bulls simple as that! Top today a Limousin from Heart of England rolling out the door at 236p/kg for a proper grading Bull with little waste. Heavy Bulls from the same saw 224p/kg with super heavies at 850kg from CH Evans & Son returning £1794 with Heart of England to £1586. Lightweight Angus from G L Pickering with O+ Grades to £1237.

Cows; A super yarding of meated Cows if not many troubling the grader at an R Grade. Meat though in abundance and well received from all corners of the ring. Young Cows just under 36 months saw 171p/kg for D J Hull & Partners whilst older Cows full of meat from the same saw 164p/kg. Weighted aged Cows in high demand seeing R Grades to 156p/kg from J K Smith & Son with DJ Hull taking 150p/kg. O+ Grades all trading 142 to 148p/kg and only the very lean dropping under 140p/kg. Top gross £1284 from Messrs Smith with others £1175 from Messrs Hull.

FORWARD SQQ 324P/KG AVG £128

Lambs hit £200!!!

A sharp increase in numbers with over 2200 sold today to the usual strong company of Buyers returned an SQQ of 324p/kg. Numbers across the country pulling returns as Supply outstrips demand for Export Lambs with French orders very hard to come across on the week. When one commodity falls though often another rises and today it was the turn of Heavy lambs trade. As Hogg supplies dry up and New Zealand Imports get used up through the Supermarkets, London Wholesale and Cutting trade seemingly prospers. Heavy lambs 43kg plus today trading at levels not seen in recent times and very dear throughout. Similarly best end lambs a retained strong trade throughout. Top today dominated by Super quality meated and shaped Beltex Lambs from J & H Tustian with 33kg to 415p/kg, 35kg to 397p/kg and 37kg to 392p/kg. Dabba Mitchell equal weight at 390p/kg. Export run of the Mill lambs generally harder to cash but 37kg from P Cobley 373p/kg and 44kg from Smith of Slapton 364p/kg whilst 40kg 360p/kg from first time vendors S & A May, Bromsgrove. Plenty of lightweight shapes for Home City trade 370 to 390p/kg. Heavies a real trade as mentioned, top today a marvellous Texel from M J Woodward at 46kg to 374p/kg with 50kg from S & A May taking 346p/kg and BJ & IS Wain 47kg to 343p/kg. RF & J Nichols 46.5kg at 342p/kg, meated Lambs with weight regularly trading over 330p/kg. A trade of two halves with huge numbers trading well over 320p/kg but the lean end 38 to 41kg lambs today lesser in quality on the week and also over supplied nationally. In the Lump Export weights totting up still with todays all in avg of £128 including large droves of lambs under 36kg sold early to meet the trade. Top today 44kg to £160 from R & B Smith, Slapton who also sold 43kg to £155. FJ Wardall & Son sold 44kg Suffolks to £150 as did MM Clarke & Sons, E Brains & Sons Ltd and JA Boulton. Heavies the headline of the day with a sudden demand for home trade heavies. Top today a marvellous £200 at 60kg from RF & J Nichols with good lambs and loyal customers well rewarded. 55kg Suffolks from David Wilson saw £176 and David Ofield 57.5kg to £175. S & A May made the journey from Bromsgrove a fruitful use of the M40 at £173 for 50kg with Messrs Nichols, Batchelor, Woodward, Ofield and Wilson all passing £170 mark again. Trade must be monitored. Numbers brought out as Vendors start to work flocks again and the weather comes favourable. Export trade falling is likely to propagate extra demand on the continent due to affordability and at this time producers are now urged to return to selling only on finish and Lambs fully fit.

Rams to £174 for Texels from R J Paybody whilst Charollais Ewes from J & R Morris saw £172 and £169 from J & R Lowe, Rugby. Most 3/4bred white faces today trading up into the £150's. Suffolks unless fat a flying trade and plenty leaving the ring at £4p/kgdw.
