Home Baking & Butchers Classes to arrive by 11:00am

Class A: The Best Fruit Cake - Open Class.

Home baking - cake to follow recipe as set out below

Ingredients

- ❖ Cake sizes 20cms/8in round- 18cm/7in square
- ❖ Cooking time 3-3½ hrs
- ❖ Currants 375g (13oz)
- ❖ Sultanas 250g (9oz)
- ❖ Rasins 150g (5oz)
- ❖ Glacè cherries (halved) 90g (4oz)

- ❖ Mixed peel 65g (3oz)
- ❖ Lemon
Grated rind and juice 1
- ❖ Orange
Grated rind and juice 1

- ❖ Plain flour 250g (9oz)
- ❖ Ground mixed spice 1¼ tsp.
- ❖ Ground nutmeg ½ tsp.
- ❖ Soft butter 200g (7oz)
- ❖ Soft brown sugar 225g (8oz)
- ❖ Black treacle 1 tbsp.
- ❖ Eggs (beaten) 5

- ❖ Ground almonds 65g (2½ oz)
- ❖ Chopped almonds 90g (3½ oz) (Optional)

- ❖ Pre-heat oven 140°C/ 275° F Gas Mark 1
- ❖ Approx baking time 3-3½ hours

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HOME BAKING

Home Baking & Butchers Classes to arrive by 11:00am

Judging to commence at 12:00pm

Class A: The Best Fruit Cake - Open Class.

Home baking - cake to follow recipe as set out below

Method

- ❖ Place all the ingredients in a large mixing bowl - I use a Kenwood Chef
- ❖ Stir to combine
- ❖ Beat the mixture for 3-5 minutes, stopping to make sure all ingredients are combined
- ❖ Spoon the mixture into the prepared tin and smooth the surface with the back of a wood tablespoon, make a slight impression in the centre to help prevent the cake from doming
- ❖ Bake in the centre of the oven
- ❖ Test the cake 30 mins before the end of baking time - cover the top with foil, if the cake browns too quickly leave cake to cool in tin - turn out leaving the lining paper in tact
- ❖ Feed the cake with Brandy or Whisky - this can be done to your liking, stanking it back on the lining paper to help keep the cake moist
- ❖ Wrap in foil until required

THE RULES OF RUGBY PRIMESTOCK SOCIETY

1. The name of the club shall be called the RUGBY PRIMESTOCK SOCIETY.
2. The committee of the Society shall all retire at each Annual General meeting, but shall be eligible for re-election. The officers of the Society shall be ex-officio members of the Committee and shall be The Chairman, The Hon Secretary and The Hon Treasurer.
3. A membership fee to the Society shall be payable each year plus an exhibitor class entry fee as shown in the schedule. This is payable prior to the show at the time of entry.
4. A closing date for entries will be displayed in the schedule.
5. No animal shall compete in more than one class, with the exception of the Supreme Championships and Special Breed Classes.
6. Entry forms will be available from the Hon. Secretary.
7. All animals entered for the competitions must have been the property of the exhibitor for not less than 2 calendar months prior to the show. Cattle passport showing ownership will be accepted.
8. All exhibited animals shown are expected to be offered for sale by auction at the show exhibited. Prize money can be withdrawn if unsold. Withdrawing prize winning stock from the show prior to the auction will pay a fine of treble the prize money won in the relevant class exhibited.
9. Cattle and sheep not meeting the required weight for any particular class will automatically be transferred to the next appropriate class at the discretion of the appointed Stewards.
10. Beast shown in halter lead classes must be quiet and manageable.
Beast shown in halter tied classes must be manageable.
Beast shown as Pairs or a Pen of cattle must be quiet and capable of being handled.
At the discretion of the Senior Steward or Judge, any animal classed to be unsafe for judging will not be considered as an entry into any show class.

THE RULES OF RUGBY PRIMESTOCK SOCIETY

11. Beast shown in non halter led classes will not be eligible for the Supreme Championships.
12. Young Farmers Classes - provided the exhibitor is a paid member of a Young Farmers Club he/she will be eligible to show stock in the respective YFC classes and championships without paying any membership or entry fees.
Young Farmers exhibiting stock in any other classes will pay the entry fee appropriate to the respective class.
13. No prize will be awarded if the Judge considers an entry to be of insufficient merit.
14. Any person protesting to any decision made by the Judges or Stewards shall deposit £20 to the Hon Secretary prior to the time of sale of the particular class on the day of the show.
The Hon Secretary shall give prior notice to three members of the committee and if such a protest is considered by them to be of trivial nature the £20 shall be retained for the benefit of the Society.
15. No rules of the Society shall be altered unless submitted and passed at the Annual General Meeting or an Extra Ordinary Annual General Meeting.
16. The Auctioneers to sell the Show animals will be appointed by the Show committee each year.
17. In order for stock to be eligible for judging, all stock must be weighed and processed as applicable, and then penned before the stated judging time. It is the exhibitors responsibility to allow sufficient time to process stock in the normal restraints of the weekly market.
