FOREWORD

It is 40 years since I sold my first store cattle in rugby market when as a spotty youth trying to make my way in farming I dreamt that cattle breeding would buy me a farm. I soon realised that only poultry were ever going to pay the mortgage and thus my cattle breeding interest would have to play second fiddle to the more sustaining pheasant breeding business.

However the cattle keeping 'hobby' had a habit of growing and ebbed and flowed to a peak of one hundred black Angus sucklers which followed my lifetimes passion for breeding hardy black polled cows.

Later as game shooting soared in popularity the demand for pheasants and partridges increased leaving me little time for keeping commercial cattle and the herd was reduced.

More recently though with the Angus breed having become overly popular my passion for breeding cattle was reignited with the introduction of polled Black Limousins. I enjoyed these years building a herd back up and the worldwide hunt for the genetics I had spent so much time studying and researching. Unfortunately though, I found that the genetics in the animals I sought, when I found them were rarely available for sale as breeders always held on to their best animals.

The best foundation cows I could afford were purchased from the Newhouse herd in Scotland and the Greensons herd closer to home and these cows were flushed intensively. I particularly sought quality cattle which were homozygous black and polled and finding little available in the UK my search took me to Canada and North America where embryo's from many different cow families were sold to me as meeting the double homozygous criteria. When born many of these embryo's did not live up to the promises I had been given and were discarded but a few certainly did and this Canadian breeding can be found in most of the cows here today along with the stock bull who carries 50% imported blood.

It should be noted that where Canadian/American blood is present in the pedigree the animals EBV 's will be reduced by the same percentage as unfortunately American EBV credits do not carry over into the British EBV system. Rest assured I only imported high genetic merit embryo's because of the import cost!

The cows are sold in their working clothes and they know only this dress as I have never been able to leave the farm during the busy summer season to partake in the show ring. As a consequence the cows are bred with more commercial traits which is obvious when viewing. Scale and extra length is apparent as are good feet and mobility along with tidy udders and teats. Big wide muzzles and nostrils are I believe absolutely essential in a suckler cow and must never be compromised whatever the breed as no cow can graze and cud properly if it has a small mouth? This trait is very apparent in the animals carrying Canadian blood where, in their home country these animals are expected to perform well on forage only diets. Cows here have been fed clamp silage only with a little hard food fed only post calving until turnout. Stores have been similarly fed and have won many rosettes over the years when sold as yearlings in the April fair in this market

Cow numbers have been much reduced over the last few years as I have tried to work out how to wind down to retirement but what are here are those cows who are not only the best maternally but also those carrying the best or the most diverse and interesting genetics. I hope that you agree with me and are able to find what you need to help you achieve your cattle breeding goals. Only four cows are being retained as they are out of the calving synch but these will come into the market in the autumn along with a lifetimes collection of cattle equipment and paraphernalia.

1	Mortality Warranty
	Subject to the conditions set out below RFM agrees to repay the hammer price of any animal sold at its auctions which dies within seven days of the date of the fall of the hammer as a direct result of a condition which existed at the time of the fall of the hammer ("the mortality warranty"). RFM will not make any payment over and above the hammer price nor reimburse any consequential losses or incidental expenses incurred.
2	Conditions
	The conditions which must be satisfied before payment by RFM pursuant to the Mortality Warranty set out in sub condition 1 above are as follows:
2.1	The Buyer must notify RFM in writing of the death of an animal which may give rise to a claim pursuant to the Mortality Warranty ("a Claim Notice") so that such Claim Notice is received in the office of RFM within 24 hours of such death and then at the Buyer's own cost produce a certificate from a qualified veterinary surgeon:
A)	Confirming the cause of death, and
b)	Confirming the veterinary surgeon's opinion that such cause existed at the time of the fall of the hammer, and
c)	Confirming whether, in the veterinary surgeon's opinion, there is anything which might give rise to the belief that at the time of the sale the vendor of such animal knew or ought to have known of, or had good reason to suspect the existence of the condition which caused the death, or of any symptoms connected with such condition. Such certificate to be produced to RFM within 48 hours of death.
2.2	If RFM so wishes, it may at its own cost obtain a certificate from the veterinary surgeon of its own choice within three days of notification of death by a Buyer.
2.3	The Buyer shall not dispose of any animal in respect of which they intend to claim pursuant to the Mortality Warranty until three days have expired since the Buyer has given a Claim Notice and given the opportunity for RFM or its nominated veterinary surgeon to inspect such animal as soon as it wishes during that time.
2.4	No payment will be made pursuant to the Mortality Warranty where RFM's veterinary surgeon certifies that the Buyer or the employee's agents, subcontractors or independent contractors engaged by the Buyer or their agents have caused or contributed to the death of the animal by the Buyer's own actions or omissions or those of the Buyer's employees agents subcontractors or independent contractors and the certificate of such veterinary surgeon shall be final and binding upon the Buyer and RFM.
