Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severely lame ie. must be full weight bearing.

More about and the first running of the Blue Tongue License proving popular with over 1400 Lambs forwards. In truth the Sale comprising of a majority of Lambs from the Blue Tongue Zone and this section the best meat with an enforced stop on drawing paying dividends.

Meat on the whole, a scarce commodity and trade fast considering the quality forwards with an all in SQQ of 296p/kg to include a selection of Store Lambs that under the new License rules are not allowed for onwards Farming but must be slaughtered. Meat the key and Buyers happy to pay.

Export Lambs starting to sell better and meat to 348p/kg for DS & LE Wadland at 40kg with M J Woodward 38 & Messrs Wadland 39kg at 340p/kg. N Deeley 333p/kg and Messrs Wadland 43kg at 330p/kg. Shape all breaking 320p/kg.

Export lambs first cross trading 295p/kg to 315p/kg with only the very lean destined for the City Market harder to place and trading 270-290p/kg. Meat though, whatever the grade, all over 300p/kg.

Heavies remain the vogue commodity simply due to these being the best selection of meat. Heavies topping at 348p/kg at 46kg for MJ Woodward with BF Humphreys 314p/kg at 49kg. Meat all over 300p/kg and easily sold. Shape weight 295p/kg to 310p/kg and Suffolks 290-300p/kg. Lean Weight still trading past 280p/kg.

An all in Avg up at £133 again today with trade remaining very favourable for a yard short on meat. Export lambs to £144 for B C Burton at 45kg and Wadland 45.5kg the same. Messrs Burton and Wadland £143 all 45.5kg.

Weight overall a top of £170 for MFH Farming with Honesbrie Farms £167 at 55kg and A J Hadley partners equal with Doug Humphrey at £166. Weight and eat and pen after pen over £150.

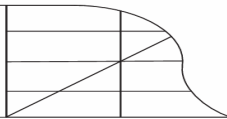
Meat is needed, trade is now expected to be on farmers side up until January and Vendors are encouraged not to rush lambs.
