Those that braved the Weather on Sunday and Monday Morning feeling the benefit of their efforts as a vard just shy of 2200 Hoggs returned and Avg of £108 per head despite 25% of the yarding weighing under 40kg. An Sqq of 248p/kg and overall avg of 242p/kg an indication of the levels of demand for Lamb meat across the country this week as supplies slowed nationally in the face of the weather. Buyers in force and some best end accounts struggling to buy lambs today for fear of selling into a negative Margin. Today a real farmers day and best end sorts richly rewarded. Proper Beltex, the like we rarely see in this region saw a top of 357p/kg at 42kg from Pete Batchelor with his 39kg to 336p/kg. Long distance travellers saw three new Customers up from Sussex on Sunday evening. O'Neil Smith Ltd, West Sussex saw 39kg to 321p/kg and 40kg at 300p/kg his consignment of 82 avg 262p/ kg. AEJ & FJ Claridge saw 43kg Beltex to 305p/kg whilst John Elkington saw 300p/ kg for 33kg. In the heavies meat wanted throughout enjoying the widest buying audience. Pete Batchelor took 47kg to 315p/kg and 46.5kg to 297p/kg, with John Elkington 267p/kg for 46kg and Messrs Claridge 47kg to 266p/kg. The gross column really totting up with handy weight lambs returning a massive £150 for 42kg from Pete Batchelor. 45kg from Pete Batchelor saw £134 and Stimson Farming Ltd saw overnight Texel x Cheviot lambs take £131.50 at 45kg. Today 220 lambs trading over £125. Overall weight wanted throughout seeing a top in the heavies of £148 for 47kg from Pete Batchelor with 58kg from Luke Stimson to £139 and 46.5kg from Pete Batchelor at £138. Heavy Suffolks from D Taylor saw 64kg to £138 for a pen full.

Trade simply marvellous for vendors. Such trade should help pull up Beef and Pork returns also, but all enthusiasm should be tempered by the producers mid to long terms Common Sense and wish for lamb not to get so dear as it is removed from the Menu or to provide a slack that may be filled by long distance importers. Trade through currently rewarding hard working farmers to feed there own people and those on the Continent whom hold British Lamb in the highest of regard.
