Lambs;

In hindsight a firm trade as all around start to tumble as it did this time last year, a trade though that was hard to take at the time. An SQQ of 294p/kg a remarkable avg as numbers come out across the Country and Export orders steady. The trade today buoyed by a new Customer for the top end lambs. Top shape today from P Jarrom selling 34kg to 368p/kg with proper meat Lambs from P Cobey to 355p/kg and Philly Batchelor 341p/kg. Pritchard Farms 339p/kg at 41kg and Messrs Webb 45kg to 334p/kg. Meat the key and heavies still an easier sale if not also seeing a massive decrease in demand. Top on the weight 311p/kg for Messrs Webb with 50kg to 307p/kg for MM Clarke & Sons. BJ & IS Wain 46kg to 307p/kg. In the lump an overall avg of £125.50 a real return when all considered. Export lambs topping at £150 for 45kg from Messrs Webb with P M Wilks 43kg to £143.50 and W V Harris & Son 44kg to £140.50. Heavies topping out at £160.50 from PC & RA Nichols at 54.5kg with MM Clarke & Sons £160 for 54kg and W V Harris & Son 53.5kg to £160. Weighted Lambs still £145 plus throughout. A hard trade with buyers lethargic but as Holidays start and a glut of Lambs appear this is always the consequence. This year Farmers have the advantage of an abundance of keep and a smaller reported lambing numbers. Vendors need only sell when fully fit.

Hoggs; A yarding of 184 Hoggs still available in July. Only a few outlets still on them but in truth a nice trade for the Commodity.

Summer Machinery Sale : 450 Lots

Today was our second sale of the year, building on the success of our first sale in March. On this very hot day and with 450 lots to sell we welcomed a large crowd, commission and telephone bids ensuring we had a good day.

We rang the bell at 10.30 prompt and started undercover with approximately 200 lots of new Hand Tools, Equipment and Ornaments, which included Spanner Sets, Socket Sets, Screwdrivers, Drill Bits, LED lights, Angle grinders, Cutting discs, Welding rods and many more items.

Highlights being a petrol Chainsaw £130, Tractor seat breakfast stools £60, Weather vanes £60 and 1/2 Oak Whiskey barrels £35.

Then outside with a row of miscellaneous Sundries, Parts, Spares and Accessories before we moved on to the Estate Management section and selling Telegraph poles to £150, 4.8M box beam barriers £57 each and 3.5M crinkle motorway barriers £21 each.

The next row contained livestock equipment, starting with the Sheep section.

We sold Sheep troughs, Ring feeders, Creep feeders and Hayrack's, Logic sheep snacker £820, IAE roll-over crate £420 and a Bateman lamb weigher £300 to name a few.

Cattle equipment followed with a Wydale 100L milk mixer £300, 5 teat calf rearer £165 and 3 teat £100 each.

We sold 3 Cattle Crushes topping at £1450, IAE cattle race £1000, 5 x 10' cattle hurdles £600, plus many other lots.
