#### PRIME CATTLE:75 HEAD

An excellent show of cattle, for numbers and meat was on offer to the usual large company of buyers with a southern family wholesaler making a welcome appearance. Trade for the working class cattle easily maintained last weeks high rates while the best struggle to reach the heights of last week.

#### Prime Bulls: 6 Head

All dairy bred native breeds this week, sold to a top of £952.32 from George Ratcliffe, Elms Way.

#### Prime Steers: 22 Head

Good numbers saw meat everywhere in the entry, and the 12 Butchers and Wholesalers at ringside easily accommodated the entry. The section and sale was topped by a superb muscled black continental from Messrs A.N. Calcott & Son, Elm Farm at 231p. Blonde's from Richard Fountaine and Family sold to 208p. Heavyweights from Elm Farm realised £1372.14 and others £1334.72 from P.Steels.

#### Prime Heifers: 30 Head

Meat everywhere in the entry, and as said previously, we have buyers for cattle of all weights and breeds but it helps if they are well fleshed. The section was topped at 225p twice from the Trivett family with two marvellous heavyweight home bred Limousin's. Richard bridesmaid again at 222p with a Black heifer and John Wrench and Family selling heavyweight Limousin's to 210p. The trade of the day was the working class meated cattle which regularly sold between 190-205p with demand outstripping supply. Heavyweights sold to £1404. from Drayton Barn Farm, with others £1372.50 Atherstone.

#### OTM's: 17 Head

A full ring of buyers for everything, however several lots of cattle were showing the weather. Top of the pops was Hillside Farms with a blue Slip heifer at 133p, followed by Messrs R.Ellis and Son at 123p with an aged Blue Cow. Top price per head was £1298.00 from Messrs Ellis for An Aberdeen Angus.

Lambs, In line with the country a steep drop in demand and trade but worryingly our SQQ of 175.6p/kg seemingly Top of the Pops for the day. Trade very sticky around and buyers complaining of little margin whatsoever. Today rows of Kenilworths usual loyal producers arriving in our sorting alleys, an indication of the state of play across the trade. In the Euro section a top of 228p/kg for shapely fed Blues from Hanbury at 40kg. Pritchard farms sold Texels to 188p/kg at 41kg and S H Moss, Leicester 38kg at 187p/kg. In the heavies a top of 186p/kg at 46kg from G R Fountaine and 185p/kg for 48kg from R Richins, Oxford. P Honour & Son, Thame 185p/kg at 47kg. MM Clarke & Sons 182p/kg at 50kg. In the lump Euro lambs to £91 for 40kg from SLAM farming with £83.50 for 45kg from Stone House Farming. B C Burton 45kg to £83. Overall G K Doyle top of the tree at £103.50 for 62kg ahead of FJ Tombs & Son (Thame) £101.50 at 58.5kg and E Taylor 61kg at £100. Abbatoirs seemingly frightened to death by the trade and unwilling to chance a single lamb more than those already pre-sold.

Nearly 1000 today and frustratingly less than 60 actually booked in. A very disappointing trade which we had expected for the week prior and despite this vendors not asking or aware of the current trade. As it turned out, a trade better than expected but we do face times where supply massively outstrips the national demand. Heavy Ewes trading £90 to £100 and mediums £80 to £60 but everything perhaps £15 less. Top today Garth Doyle at £100 with Dorsets ahead of Texel pens to £95 from Showell Farms. Suffolks to £90 and top Mules to K Butcher, Essex. Light and lean Ewes almost worthless and buyers happy not to be given them at any price.

#### Store Cattle: 104 forward

The beginning of the Store Cattle season but still very much a small yarding indicative of the time of year. Young and medium aged cattle understandably less as buyers unsure as to buy and turn them away onto the limited grass or try and feed them the fodder they do not have. Heavy varding cattle though a real trade and buyers all around for them and seemingly needing more. 15 month old Bucket reared calves from M W Warner saw Angus to £770 with yearling Blondes from Roger Wixey £750. Large pens of Angus Bucket reared Calves from O Johnson to £650. Up the ages and up the trade. Strong 12 to 16 month Angus Steers from Messrs Root, Leicester saw £910 with older brothers at 20 months £1100 17 to 20 month olds of the same breeding £1135. 22 – 24 month Angus started on Buckets from Ollie Johnson saw £1120 and older Simmentals from D Sharlot saw 24 month Steers at £1180 with Herefords £1150. Toppping the trade though for a pen of 7 was J H Thomas, Flore seeing 26 - 27 month old Charolais Steers at £1190. We now ramp up to the winter.
