Meat the order of the day and some expert finishers now in attendance. Top today 296p/kg for a super Limousin U grade Steer not all shape but full of loin and finish from Ralph Tustian selling to 296p/kg. Weighted Steers from F Hodgkin to 262 & 260p/kg from F Hodgkin. Fed R Grades to 256p/kg for Angus from R & T Reeve heavies to 247.5p/kg and 244p/kg from Heckford. O+ Cattle into the 230p/ kg's. Top gross £1995 for Messrs Tustian with £1965 for Hodgkin and £1877 from Henry Tustian.

Heifers;

Smart runs of Cattle and more meat albeit no superstars on show. Top 297p/kg for Blues from Ralph Tustian with others 289p/kg for Shop Heifers. Best U- to 280p/kg from Fountaines and R Grades well in to the 260p/kg range. O+ Cattle to 248p/kg. Top gross £2067 for Tustian with Fountaine £1820 and Messrs Tustian £1805.

Bulls;

All grades and shapes today. A super shaped Limousin from J & R Lowe up from Rugby to see 296p/ kg. Weighted Simmentals from C H Evans saw 240p/kg and 233.5p/kg whilst aged Lincoln Reds down from their Native Lincolnshire saw 220p/kg at 30 months of age. Holstein extremes to 187p/kg. 2803 Hoggs and plenty of weight. Trade often dips through the day but today trade did rally later on. Harder sales reported on the Continent not aided by the issues at the Ferry Ports. Trade back on the week and definatley the edge off. That said good Export Weight Lambs generally over 300p/kg and certainly north of 290p/kg to produce an SQQ of 286p/kg. Hoggs weighing 42.5kg to 48kg again finding a dead spot with 45 to 48kg Hoggs seeing little increase in value for weight at all. Heavies plentiful throughout and a stagnant trade that is over supplied Nationally. Shape and meat still rewarded and Export weights just as dear as 12 months ago. Export Hoggs seeing super quality from P Batchelor at 43kg to 363p/kg and 42kg from J & H Tustian at 354p/kg. City weight shape 33kg 348p/kg from Tommy Tustian. Fed meat 43kg from Humphrey Livestock to 347p/kg. Heavies a smart trade for top sorts but run of the mill supply exceeding demand Nationally. P Batchelor a top of 49.5kg to 349p/kg with perfect Beltex whist long distance travellers LA Hogue Farms Shop over from Norfolk to see 49kg to 347p/kg. Leam Farms sold 46kg to 330p/kg and Batchelor 49.5kg to 324p/kg. In the lump Export weights saw a top of 43kg to £156 for Pete Batchelor with £149 at 43kg from Humphrey Livestock. Plenty of best End Hoggs over £140. In the lump £121 for 50kg and price climbing for weight the run of the mill. That said best meat and weight chased seeing an overall top of £173 for 49.5kg from Batchelor with 49kg to £170 for LA Hogue Farm Shop and 59kg £164 for P Batchelor. WG & SW Jones showed best shape 57kg at £161. Crabtree then various pens 58kg to 61kg at £160 plus. Trade faltering a little and standard heavies now all backing up. Again vendors should think to avoid selling 44kg to 50kg weights and look at better marketing weights that hold trade advantage. Today some very dirty Hoggs. These cannot be marketed similarly far too many in-lamb Hoggs found. A Polite Notice: Teeth Hoggs now being detected and Vendors reminded that Teeth up cannot be sold in the UK as whole bodies and must be split. It is the vendors responsibility to Mouth Sheep and any deductions are sadly not insured as it is a Sale under the Misdescriptions Act.

NSA Best lambs Champions – P Cobley 36.5kg Best Pen of Charollais Sired Lambs – Martin Morris 39.5kg. 2nd – Smith & Baxter 42kg 3rd – D Dashwood 41kg

A nice swift trade but in honesty too much weight about with Lambs over 40kg harder to shift with cutting outlets not yet ready to process lamb. Butchers and City trade the main stay for today with Exporters propping the trade. Top today a super 3.5kg Texel from M Toon at 364p/kg with the Champions 356p/kg and 35kg from Morris 353p/kg. Most Lambs trading north of £130 with 41.5kg to £140 for P Cobley and 42kg from D Dashwood £139.50 his 41kg £138. 38 to 40kg Lambs regularly £135. Heavies a much harder sell but topping at £146 for 50.5kg from Smith & Baxter and 49kg from RC & J Mann £145.5. Labs should be marketed 35kg plus as long as fully meat. Lean Lamb trade not yet apparent with plenty of Hoggs to feed the Asian trade.


