In the heavies 47.5kg to 201p/kg from Humprey Livestock. 50kg from Angela Tarry-Smith to 200p/kg with 49kg from Humphrey Livestock 198p/kg. Heavies a storming trade. In the gross Euro lambs to £88.50 for 45kg from Harrison Bros, Aylesbury with B C Burton 45kg for £87.50. Ben selling 104 lambs to avg exactly £90.
