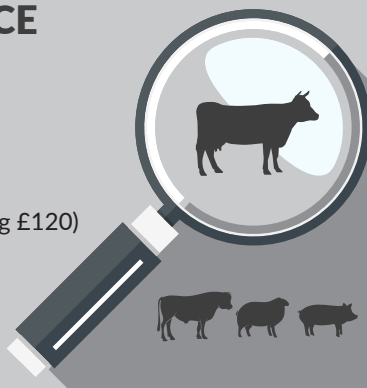

Lambs; More numbers forwards but a lot of leaner types forward and on the whole a lack of meat and finish. Buyers about but still no real kick on of trade as numbers remain plentiful in the north. An SQQ of 270p/kg a fast return with a fair dew lambs very short on finish. Better end lambs remain in best demand seeing one of the last Lots of the day to 340p/kg at 45kg from N Deeley with Messrs Fountaine 338p/kg and M J Woodward 42 to 37kg at 333p/kg and R Richins, Oxford 43kg at 326p/kg. Today best meat and finish regularly rewarded to over 300p/kg. Leaner Export lambs 255-265p/kg with a large supply of this category. Heavies remain well chased for meat with the edge off the leaner weighted Lambs today. Topping at 46kg and 304p/kg for 46kg from SLAM Farming with BJ & I Wain 47.5kg at 299p/kg and 57kg at 298p/kg for C Stubbs with Rouge Lambs. L Swerling 53kg at 298p/kg. Meat commanding 270p/kg pus whatever the weight today. An all in avg of £120 today the real top figure. Export Lambs to £153 at 45kg from N Deeley with M Woodward 42kg to £140, R Richins 43kg at £140 and W G Kind & Sons 44kg at £140. Weight though pays and meat and shape the perfect mix form C Stubbs with overnight lambs to 57kg at £170 and JK Smith & Sons 65kg to £160. L Swerling 53kg to £158 and JK Smith & Sons 65kg to £157..

Christmas trade still not upon us and lets hope it comes. All abattoirs now having issues with dirty bellies and these must be remedied. We commence belly clipping this Sunday with all overnight lambs subject to compulsory Clipping. Gates close strictly at 4pm.!!!!

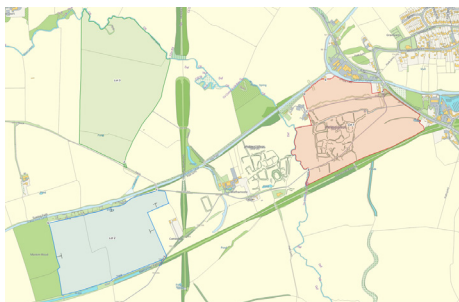
